

Chapter 5 Health Promotion for the Developing Child

Growth and Development

- Growth
 - An increase in the number and size of cells.
 - Easily and accurately measured.
 - Growth is a predictable process with standard measurement methods.
- Development
 - Development is a predictable and orderly process that occurs at varying rates within normal limits.
 - The increases in rate of function and complexity can vary normally within limits for each child.
 - Development proceeds in a proximodistal (beginning at the middle and going outwards) with fine muscle organization occurring as a result of large muscle organization.
 - Development is a more complex process than growth and is affected by many factors; therefore, it is less easily and less accurately measured.
- Learning and maturation
- Stages of Growth and Development
 - Parameters of growth
 - Weight, length, and height are used to monitor growth.
 - WEIGHT: double at 6 months and triple by 1 yr. Example: If an infants birth wt. is 7 pounds and 8 ounces, what should the nurse project the wt. to be at 6 months? ANS: 15 lbs.
 - Head circumference indicates brain growth.
 - Eruption of teeth also follows a sequential pattern.
 - 6-8 months old: Primary dentition begins
 - 1 year: 6 teeth, 4 above and 2 below
 - 2 ½ years: 20 teeth
 - 6 years: Permanent teeth (32) begin erupting at age 6, accompanied by the loss of primary teeth.
 - Eruption of teeth is not a sign of maturation and is not related to the level or rate of development.
 - A dental visit by 1 year of age is recommended by the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry.
 - Growth spurts (Box 5.1 pg. 64)
