Tangier Iain Finlayson, 1992 **Tangier** Richard Hamilton, 2019-06-27 In this first guide to Tangier's extraordinary cultural history former BBC North Africa correspondent Richard Hamilton explores the city to find out what has inspired so many international writers artists and musicians In Tangier the Moroccan novelist Mohamed Choukri wrote everything is surreal and everything is possible In this intimate portrait Hamilton explores hotels cafés alleyways and the city's darkest secrets Delving down through complex historical layers he finds a frontier town that is comic confounding and haunted by the ghosts of its past Samuel Pepys thought God should destroy Tangier and St Francis of Assisi called it a city of madness and delusions Yet throughout the centuries it has also been a crucible of creativity It was a turning point in Henri Matisse's artistic journey and had a profound impact on the founder of the Rolling Stones Brian Jones Tangier also produced two of the greatest American novels of the twentieth century *The Sheltering Sky* and *Naked Lunch* Besides Paul Bowles and William Burroughs the book also looks at lesser known characters such as the flawed genius Brion Gysin as well as Ibn Battuta who travelled three times further than Marco Polo Featuring a thrilling cast of pirates sultans artists musicians writers princes and playboys this is an essential read about Tangier **Tangier/Gibraltar - A Tale of One City** Dieter Haller, 2021-05-10 Contemporary life is caught in prisons of identity Public academic and political discourses do not seem to be possible without circling around the topos of identity thereby creating an illusion of uniqueness separation difference and conflict By studying the relationship between the Moroccan city of Tangiers and the British overseas territory of Gibraltar Dieter Haller shows how cross boundary experiences practices and identifications create a sense of neighborhood beyond official discourses Across the Straits of Gibraltar local and regional relationships in different fields such as kinship economy and culture provide resources for post Brexit common action and a future beyond the prison of identity *Paul Bowles's Literary Engagement with Morocco* Bouchra Benlemlih, 2018-01-05 This study argues that Paul Bowles is more perceptive than many American travelers in Morocco The book provides us with what are perhaps the most sustained meditations to date on Bowles's translation work and his autobiography as well as perceptive analyses of key stories such as *A Distant Episode* and *Here to Learn* and his second novel *Let It Come Down* set primarily in Tangier The chapter on translation dwells on the complex interactions between Moroccan storytellers and Bowles The work considers translation as a site where the oral and written colonial and post colonial scene and English and Maghrebi come face to face it is a place where things are worked out in dynamic interaction The chapter on Bowles's autobiography *Without Stopping* urges us to take this piece of self writing famously dubbed *Without Telling* by William Burroughs more seriously drawing our attention to baroque architectural features of mind and external landscape worlds distorted by mirrors dreams and fluid transit where forms morph The work also highlights difference between experience and representation of experience through language transformed through the prism of memory In the chapter on *Without Stopping* as well as in my discussions of Bowles's fiction I provide useful

elaborations of connections between Bowles's work and that of Edgar Allan Poe. My reading of one of Bowles's best known stories *A Distant Episode* brings to the surface a recognition that the tragic fate of the Professor the story's protagonist is an outcome of his inability to admit that cultures are not static. The academically trained linguist demonstrates an unwillingness or inability to adapt to change or to read cultural signs accurately. The message is that Morocco is not stuck in time and cannot be held in place by Orientalist fantasies or preconceived externally derived intellectual constructs and assumptions. The book concludes that against the grain of Samuel Huntington's notion of *Clash of Civilizations*, Bowles's poetic and geographical journey forcefully projects cosmopolitanism and transnational attention confirming that civilizations and identities open up rather than shut down war or clash.

Writing Tangier Ralph M. Coury, Robert Kevin Lacey, 2009. *Writing Tangier* discusses an array of topics relating to the literature on Tangier from the seventeenth century to the present. Major questions include: Why has Tangier come to play an important role in contemporary world literary history as a signifier in the literary imagination? What is the nature of the intertextual output produced through Paul Bowles' translations of the oral tales of a circle of uneducated storytellers including Mohammed Mrabet and Larbi Layachi and the text *For Bread Alone* brought to Bowles by the literate Mohamed Choukri? How do academics, artists and writers who have been based in the city or who have written about it assess the various socio-economic, political and cultural factors that have shaped its cultural production and the relationship of this production to the celebrated hybrid aspects of its identity? Does the success of the literature of Tangier reflect a truly new multicultural cosmopolitanism or does it stem from the fact that this literature is congenial to Westerners that it is understood in terms that they themselves define and that much of it, including productions in Arabic prepared with the expectation of translation, has even been written to measure for them.

Up the Kasbah Tony Walton, 2011-11-08. Starting with Oscar Wilde and Andr  Gide in the 1890s for the next 100 years North Africa was to be a favourite destination for gay men seeking a mixture of sea, sand, sunshine and maybe something else. This book relates the adventures and antics of those gay travellers and expats in the three countries of Morocco, Algeria and Tunisia between 1890 and 1990. Much of it is based on their own words given to us in interviews. Many of the destinations mentioned here along the north African coast were visited by either Wilde, Gide or Genet. But it is Tangier where we spend the most time since that city was for over fifty years the Mecca of gay travellers. So as you read, imagine yourself up in the Kasbah of each of the old cities looking down and seeing what those gays are doing down in the main part of the town. We are sure you will find something of interest.

The African City Bill Freund, 2007-03-05. This book is comprehensive both in terms of time coverage from before the Pharaohs to the present moment and in that it tries to consider cities from the entire continent, not just Sub-Saharan Africa. Apart from factual information and rich description material culled from many sources, it looks at many issues from why urban life emerged in the first place to how present-day African cities cope in difficult times. Instead of seeing towns and cities as somehow extraneous to the real Africa, it views them as an inherent part of developing Africa, indigenous, colonial and

post colonial and emphasizes the extent to which the future of African society and African culture will likely be played out mostly in cities The book is written to appeal to students of history but equally to geographers planners sociologists and development specialists interested in urban problems

Interwar Symphonies and the Imagination Emily MacGregor, 2023-01-26 The symphony has long been entangled with ideas of self and value Though standard historical accounts suggest that composers interest in the symphony was almost extinguished in the early 1930s this book makes plain the genre s continued cultural dominance and argues that the symphony can illuminate issues around space geography race and postcolonialism in Germany France Mexico and the United States Focusing on a number of symphonies composed or premiered in 1933 this book recreates some of the cultural and political landscapes of an uncertain historical moment a year when Hitler took power in Germany and the Great Depression reached its peak in the United States Interwar Symphonies and the Imagination asks what North American and European symphonies from the early 1930s can tell us about how people imagined selfhood during a period of international insecurity and political upheaval of expansionist and colonial fantasies scientised racism and emergent fascism
