Example If what Source A says is supported by Source B, then Source A is reliable, and hence useful.	▶ Simply copy information from or paraphrase the source ▶ Simply dismiss the source as unreliable or biased. ▶ Simply end the paragraph on checking reliability with "Thus Source A is reliable" without linking back to the usefulness of the source.
