Each part of speech which include nouns, pronouns, adverbs, adjectives and verbs. Each part plays a role in giving the sentence its meaning. Depending on the language a sentence has a structure based on the language grammar. Setswana uses a disjunctive orthography. That is, in some cases a few tokens (words) are written separately but are only meaningful as a unit. Individual words play different functions in a sentence depending on words around them. This poses a great challenge as a word could have many functions as also explain in [6]. For example the word *ba* could be:

- 1) a possessive concord: *batho ba gagwe* (his people)
- 2) a relative concord: *ba ba lemanang* (those planting)
- 3) a pronoun: *ba a tsamaya* (they are going)
- 4) a demonstrative: *batho ba* (these people)
