Crime Fiction in the Caribbean Lucy Evans, 2024-09-18 Crime Fiction in the Caribbean Reframing Crime and Justice is the first academic book to focus on crime fiction by anglophone Caribbean writers It explores how contemporary writers experiment with the crime genre in order to convey contextualize and comment on crime and justice in Caribbean countries Lucy Evans reads crime fiction as a versatile mode of writing that can be politically engaged and that in a Caribbean context can expose power structures embedded in the region's multi layered history of colonial conquest genocide of Indigenous populations plantation agriculture transatlantic slavery and indentured labour This book covers fiction set in Trinidad and Tobago Jamaica Guyana Barbados Grenada and Haiti discussing novels by Elizabeth Nunez Jacob Ross Marlon James Harischandra Khemraj Esther Figueroa Edwidge Danticat Cherie Jones and several others Evans considers how fiction by anglophone Caribbean writers not only reflects upon the social realities of crime and crime control in the Caribbean but also at times contests or complicates scholarly popular and legal perspectives She argues that through their engagement with the crime genre these writers raise pressing questions about what constitutes crime and justice in a Caribbean context and about accountability Looking beyond the traditional focus of crime fiction and criminology on individual acts of wrongdoing their fiction highlights systemic social harms rooted in the region's colonial past Reading crime fiction through the lens of criminological research Crime Fiction in the Caribbean brings the study of literary writing into scholarly debate on crime in the Caribbean At the same time it extends the global turn in crime fiction studies focusing on a region that has been sidelined even in studies which examine the genre's international dimensions

National Women's Health Survey for Trinidad and Tobago Cecile Pemberton,Joel Joseph,2018-03-06 This report presents the first nationally representative estimates of the prevalence of

intimate partner violence IPV and non partner sexual violence NPSV against women in Trinidad and Tobago The data come from the 2017 Trinidad and Tobago Women s Health Survey WHS a national quantitative cross sectional survey of 1 079 women ages 15 64 The report finds that 30 percent of ever partnered women experienced physical and or sexual violence by an intimate partner in their lifetime and 6 percent in the 12 months prior to data collection Seven percent of all respondents reported having been forced into sexual intercourse by a non partner in their lifetime 1 percent in the last 12 months Significant risk factors associated with IPV identified using Chi square tests included lower education female and partner cohabitation without marriage rural residency younger age non consensual marriage having been pregnant having experienced or witnessed violence in childhood substance abuse by the partner and the partner being unemployed and having been in prior relationships The report documents the negative consequences of IPV for women and their children as well as the most common responses and coping mechanisms One in three women who experienced IPV remained quiet about their experience and most survivors did not seek or receive assistance for their situation Women most often sought help from their personal contacts mostly their mothers rather than police social services or other entities adequately resourced to address IPV Several factors precluded women from accessing help these included fear shame and the normalcy associated with violence Based on these findings recommendations for policy and further research are presented

A Critical Analysis of the Efficacy of Law as a Tool to Achieve Gender Equality Natalie Persadie, 2012-07-26 Law is often perceived as an instrument that can effect social change While this might be so it must be complemented by the necessary financial and human resources to make the law effective Natalie Persadie explains that among developing countries such as Trinidad and Tobago the achievement of legal advances for women at either the international or national levels is particularly difficult where practical measures are not subsequently implemented This is perhaps attributable to a lack of political will Important issues such as gender equality and domestic violence are not given priority and laws aimed at protecting women and promoting women s rights are ineffective scant or unenforced Gender justice can only be realized through a multilevel approach from above and more importantly from below as women have the potential to effect real national and international legal and institutional change to ensure gender equality at both levels

Coolie Woman Gaiutra Bahadur, 2022-12-22 Shortlisted for the Orwell Prize Bahadur combines her journalistic eye for detail and story telling gifts with probing questions a haunting portrait The Independent In 1903 a young woman sailed from India to Guiana as a coolie the British name for indentured laborers who replaced the newly emancipated slaves on sugar plantations all around the world Pregnant and traveling alone this woman like so many coolies disappeared into history Now in Coolie Woman her great granddaughter embarks on a journey into the past to find her Traversing three continents and trawling through countless colonial archives Gaiutra Bahadur excavates not only her great grandmother s story but also the repressed history of some quarter of a million other coolie women shining a light on their complex lives Shunned by society and sometimes in mortal danger many coolie

women were runaways widows or outcasts Many left husbands and families behind to migrate alone in epic sea voyages traumatic middle passages only to face a life of hard labor dismal living conditions and especially sexual exploitation As Bahadur explains however it is precisely their sexuality that makes coolie women stand out as figures in history Greatly outnumbered by men they were able to use sex with their overseers to gain various advantages an act that often incited fatal retaliations from coolie men and sometimes larger uprisings of laborers against their overlords Complex and unpredictable sex was nevertheless a powerful tool Examining this and many other facets of these remarkable women s lives Coolie Woman is a meditation on survival a gripping story of a double diaspora from India to the West Indies in one century Guyana to the United States in the next that is at once a search for roots and an exploration of gender and power peril and opportunity
