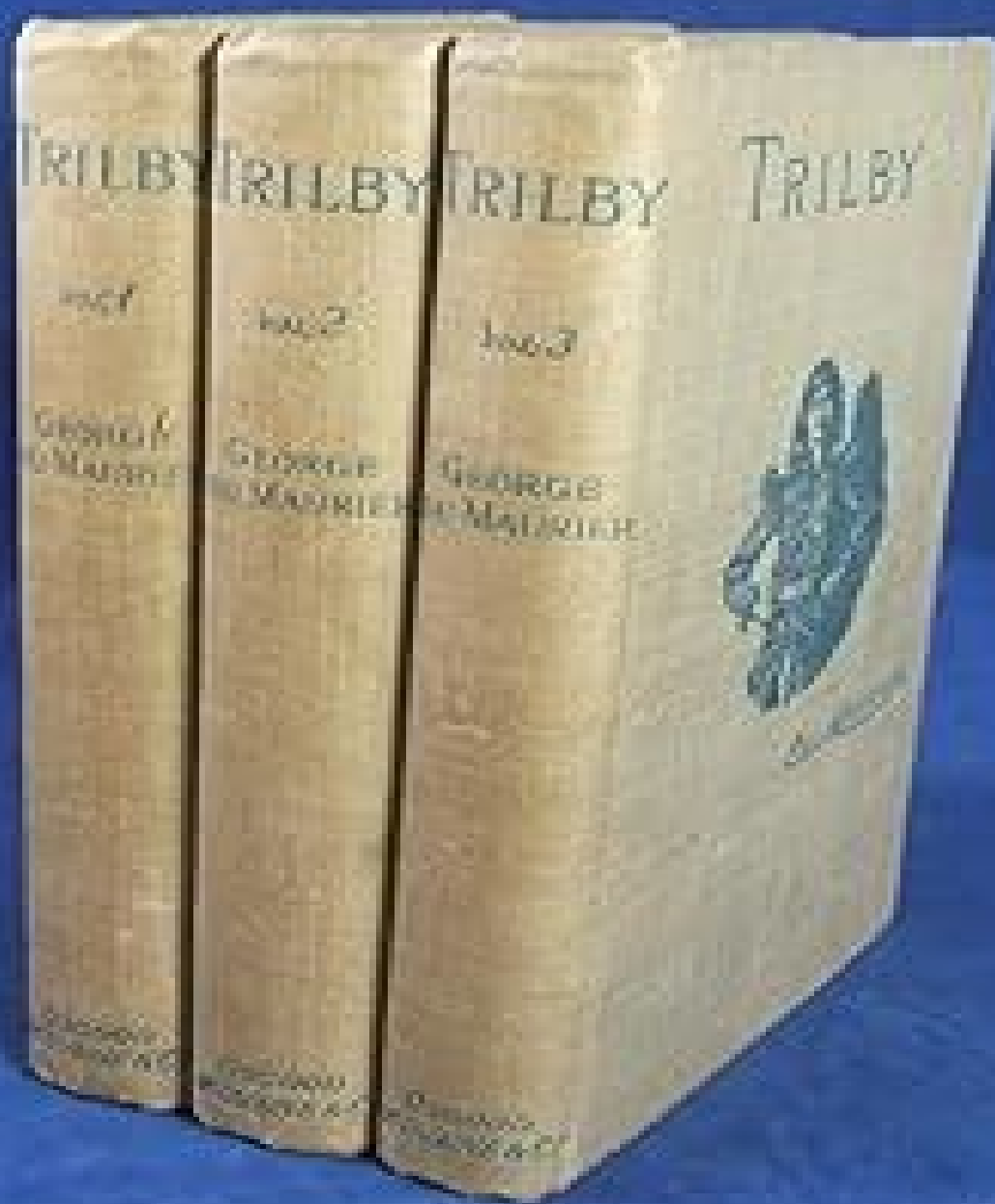

Montgomery Ward & Co., Montgomery Ward, 1969-08-01 Tea gowns bleached damask and yards of flannel and pillow case lace stereoscopes books of gospel hymns and ballroom gems the New Improved Singer Sewing Machine side saddles anti freezing well pumps Windsor Stoves milk skimmers straight edged razors high button shoes woven cane carpet beaters spittoons the Studebaker Road Cart commodes and washstands the Fire Fly single wheel hoe cultivator and plow combined flat irons and ice cream freezers What man woman or child of the 1890s could resist these offerings of the Montgomery Ward catalogue the one book that was read avidly year after year by millions of Americans on farms and in small towns across the nation The Montgomery Ward catalogue provides one of the few irrefutably accurate pictures of what life was really like in the gay nineties for it described and illustrated almost anything that anybody could possibly need or want in the way of store bought goods In fact in that pre department store era it was usually the only source for such goods Imagine if Montgomery Ward had issued an illustrated catalogue in the days of Louis XIV or Elizabeth I or Charlemagne what insights would we have into the daily life of the common folk the farmers and shopkeeper housewives and schoolchildren what sources of information for historians and scholars collectors and dealers what models for artists and designers In 1895 Montgomery Ward was the oldest largest and most representative mail order house in the country The brainchild of a former traveling salesman it issued its first catalogue in 1872 a one page listing of items By 1895 the catalogue reprinted here had grown to 624 pages and listed some 25 000 items almost all of them illustrated with live drawings Montgomery Ward was by then a multi million dollar business that profoundly affected the American economy and since it reached the most isolated farms and backwoods cabins its effect on American culture was almost as great Now once again available it is our truest most unbiased record of the spirit of the 1890s An introduction on the history of the Montgomery Ward Company and its catalogue has been prepared especially for this edition by Boris Emmet Ph D Johns Hopkins a foremost expert on retail merchandising His monumental work *Catalogues and Counters* has long been recognized as a landmark in the study of American economic history

The Bookman ,1895 **Adventures in Criticism** Sir Arthur Thomas Quiller-Couch,2020-09-28 And I seem to see in this edition of Chaucer the beginning of the realization of a dream which I have cherished since first I stood within the quadrangle of the Clarendon Press that fine combination of the factory and the palace The aspect of the Press itself repeats as it were the characteristics of its government which is conducted by an elected body as an honorable trust Its delegates are not intent only on money getting And yet the Clarendon Press makes money and the University can depend upon it for handsome subsidies It may well depend upon it for much more As the Bank of England to which in its system of government it may be likened is the focus of all the other banks private or joint stock in the kingdom and the treasure house not only of the nation s gold but of its commercial honor so the Clarendon Press traditionally careful in its selections and munificent in its rewards might become the academy or central temple of English literature If it would but follow up Professor Skeat s Chaucer with a resolution to publish at a pace suitable to so large an undertaking all the great English classics edited with all the scholarship its wealth can command I believe that before long the Clarendon Press would be found to be exercising an influence on English letters which is at present lacking and the lack of which drives many to call from time to time for the institution in this country of something corresponding to the French Academy I need only cite the examples of the Royal Society and the Marylebone Cricket Club to show that to create an authority in this manner is consonant with our national practice We should have that centre of correct information correct judgment correct taste that intellectual metropolis in short which is the surest check upon provinciality in literature we should have a standard of English scholarship and an authoritative dictionary of the English language and at the same time we should escape all that business of the green coat and palm branches which has at times exposed the French Academy to much vulgar intrigue

The Idea of Music in Victorian Fiction Nicky Losseff,2016-03-03 The Idea of Music in Victorian Fiction seeks to address fundamental questions about the function meaning and understanding of music in nineteenth century culture and society as mediated through works of fiction The eleven essays here written by musicologists and literary scholars range over a wide selection of works by both canonical writers such as Austen Benson Carlyle Collins Gaskell Gissing Eliot Hardy du Maurier and Wilde and less well known figures such as Gertrude Hudson and Elizabeth Sara Sheppard Each essay explores different strategies for interpreting the idea of music in the Victorian novel Some focus on the degree to which scenes involving music illuminate what music meant to the writer and contemporary performers and listeners and signify musical tastes of the time and the reception of particular composers Other essays in the volume examine aspects of gender race sexuality and class that

are illuminated by the deployment of music by the novelist Together with its companion volume *The Figure of Music in Nineteenth Century British Poetry* edited by Phyllis Weliver Ashgate 2005 this collection suggests a new network of methodologies for the continuing cultural and social investigation of nineteenth century music as reflected in that period's literary output *Women Musicians in Victorian Fiction, 1860-1900* Phyllis Weliver, 2018-02-06 This title was first published in 2000 Phyllis Weliver investigates representations of female musicians in British novels from 1860 to 1900 with regard to changing gender roles musical practices and scientific discourses During this time women were portrayed in complex and nuanced ways as they played and sang in family drawing rooms Women in the 19th century were judged on their manners appearance language and other accomplishments such as sewing or painting but music stood out as an area where women were encouraged to take centre stage and demonstrate their genteel education graceful movements and self expression However within the novels of the Victorian were beginning to move away from portraying the musical accomplishments of middle and upper class women as feminine and worthwhile towards depicting musical women as truly dangerous This book explores the reasons for this reaction and the way labels and images were constructed to show extremes of behaviour and it looks at whether the fiction was depicting the real trends in music at the time *George Du Maurier: Illustrator, Author, Critic* Simon Cooke, Paul Goldman, 2017-05-15 Though well known as the author of *Trilby* and the creator of Svengali the writer artist George Du Maurier had many other accomplishments that are less familiar to modern audiences This collection traces Du Maurier's role as a participant in the wider cultural life of his time restoring him to his proper status as a major Victorian figure Divided into sections the volume considers Du Maurier as an artist illustrator and novelist who helped to form some of the key ideas of his time The contributors place his life and work in the context of his treatment of Judaism and Jewishness his fascination with urbanization Victorian science technology and clairvoyance his friendships and influences and his impact on notions of consumerism and taste As an illustrator Du Maurier collaborated with Thomas Hardy Elizabeth Gaskell and sensational writers such as M E Braddon and the author of *The Notting Hill Mystery* These partnerships along with his reflections on the art of illustration are considered in detail Impossible to categorize Du Maurier was an Anglo Frenchman with cultural linkages in France England and America a social commentator with an interest in *The New Woman* a Punch humourist and a friend of Henry James with whom he shared a particular interest in the writing of domesticity and domestic settings Closing with a consideration of Du Maurier's after life notably the treatment of his work in film this collection highlights his diverse achievements and makes a case for his enduring significance
