Troublemakers Dieter Thomä, 2019-07-12 The political crises and upheavals of our age often originate from the periphery rather than the center of power. Figures like Edward Snowden, Julian Assange, and Chelsea Manning acted in ways that disrupted power, revealing truths that those in power wanted to keep hidden. They are thorns in the side of power, troublemakers in the eyes of the powerful, though their actions may be valuable and lead to positive changes. In this important new book, Dieter Thomä examines the crucial but often overlooked function of these figures on the margins of society, developing a philosophy of troublemakers from the seventeenth century to the present day. Thomä takes as his starting point Hobbes's idea of the *puer robustus*, literally stout boy, meaning a figure who rebels against order and authority. While Hobbes saw the *puer robustus* as a threat, he also recognized the potential in the right conditions for figures to rise up and become agents of positive change. Building on this notion, Thomä provides a rich survey of intellectuals who have been inspired by this idea over the past 300 years, from Rousseau, Diderot, Schiller, Victor Hugo, Marx, and Freud to Carl Schmitt, Leo Strauss, and Horkheimer, right up to the recent work of Badiou and Agamben. In doing so, he develops a typology of the *puer robustus* and a means by which we can evaluate and assess the troublemakers of our own times. Thomä shows that troublemakers are an inescapable part of modernity; for as soon as social and political boundaries are defined, there will always be figures challenging them from the margins. This book will be of great interest not only to students and scholars in the humanities and social sciences but to anyone seeking to understand the crucial impact of these liminal figures on our world today.

The result is a visual and written history that complicates and even upends the morality tales and popular memory of postwar freedom struggles. Shay himself was a troublemaker seeking to unsettle society by illuminating truths that many middle-class white media, political, and businesspeople pretended did not exist. Shay served as a navigator in the US Army Air Forces during World War II, then took a position as a writer for *Life* magazine. But soon after his 1948 move to Chicago, he decided to become a freelance photographer. Shay wandered the city, photographing whatever caught his eye, and much did. His lens captured everything from private moments of rebellion to era-defining public movements, as he sought to understand the creative and destructive energies that propelled freedom struggles in the Windy City. Shay illuminated the pain and ecstasy that sprung up from the

streets of Chicago while Gellman reveals their collective impact on the urban fabric and on our national narrative This collaboration offers a fresh and timely look at how social conflict can shape a city and may even inspire us to make trouble today Fascinating Chicago Tribune *Troublemakers* William Scott,2011-11-02 William Scott's *Troublemakers* explores how a major change in the nature and forms of working class power affected novels about U S industrial workers in the first half of the twentieth century With the rise of mechanization and assembly line labor from the 1890s to the 1930s these laborers found that they had been transformed into a class of mass workers who since that time have been seen alternately as powerless degraded victims or heroic empowered icons who could rise above their oppression only through the help of representative organizations located outside the workplace Analyzing portrayals of workers in such novels as Upton Sinclair's *The Jungle* Ruth McKenney's *Industrial Valley* and Jack London's *The Iron Heel* William Scott moves beyond narrow depictions of these laborers to show their ability to resist exploitation through their direct actions sit down strikes sabotage and other spontaneous acts of rank and file troublemaking on the job often carried out independently of union leadership The novel of the mass industrial worker invites us to rethink our understanding of modern forms of representation through its attempts to imagine and depict workers agency in an environment where it appears to be completely suppressed

Ducey,2022-08-23 During the period 1769 1850 republican national institutions slowly replaced colonial and monarchical rule This was a turbulent time in rural Mexico It was a period of political instability marked by violent peasant rebellions that were longer more violent and involved more people than those that occurred in the colonial era Mexican villagers became skilled insurrectionists In this book Michael Ducey analyzes the peasant rebellions in Mexico s Huasteca region over that time beginning with short lived colonial riots progressing through a long and brutal insurrection associated with the war of independence and several region wide uprisings and culminating in the Caste War of the Huasteca of the 1840s He asks not just why villagers revolted but how their discontent fit into the political drama of early national Mexico Ducey shows how the war offered opportunities for villagers to settle scores with members of the local elite as peasants discovered new ways of imagining the state They were far from being the isolated traditionalists who occasionally rebelled against political or economic change described in older scholarship At least until the 1848 1850 Caste War political disputes were more important than land This region s peasants were both remarkably diverse and politically astute Villagers adapted colonial political culture and later republican ideas to fashion local institutions that fit their own needs Over the course of a hundred years peasant tactics and political discourse evolved in a constant dialogue with the changing political climate shifting from rhetorical statements of loyalty to the king to proclamations of federalism and their rights as citizens A Nation of Villages ably demonstrates that rural villagers were more aware of elite ideologies than urban rulers were of the villagers political ideas This long term analysis of one region illuminates how rural people helped shape the republican state
