

Running the UVO

You can run the UVO in the system to use the service.

On the All Menus screen, press **UVO**.



- ① Returns to the previous step.
- ② Call to the Roadside Assistance using the UVO service. ► See "Contacting for roadside assistance."
- ③ Can see the weather information (if equipped). ► See "Checking the weather information (if equipped)."
- ④ Checks your vehicle for abnormal conditions and displays the result. ► See "Diagnosing the vehicle."
- ⑤ See the information about the intervals for the last and next maintenance services (if equipped). ► See "Checking maintenance service intervals (if equipped)."
- ⑥ Call the UVO Center to request help or make inquiries about using the UVO service.
- ⑦ Call the UVO Center and request assistance regarding use of the UVO service, including information on subscribing to the UVO service and service activation.
- ⑧ Access the UVO service to use it on the system, activate the automatic 911 connection feature, or access modem information.
- ⑨ The list of menu items appears.
 - **Display Off:** Turns off the screen. To switch the screen back on, press the screen or briefly press the power knob.
 - **User's Manual on Web (QR Code):** Displays the QR code that provides access to the online user manual for the system.

 The screen may differ depending on the vehicle model and specifications.
