The Cardinal Virtues in the Middle Ages István Bejczy, 2011-08-11 Despite its non-Christian origins the scheme of the cardinal virtues prudence justice fortitude and temperance found wide acceptance in medieval theology philosophy and religious literature The present study is the first to investigate the history of the four virtues in the Latin Middle Ages from patristic times to the late fourteenth century It examines the position of the cardinal virtues between religious and secularized conceptions of morality and attempts to reveal some distinctly Christian aspects of medieval virtue theory notwithstanding its manifest indebtedness to ancient ethics Exploring learned and popularizing sources alike including much unedited material this study covers a broad spectrum of moral debate during ten centuries of Western intellectual history

Knowing My Inner Self Fazel

Naghdy, 2014-06-06 *Knowing my inner self* is written for teenagers to assist them in their journey to discover inner self and to cultivate their hidden capacities as they blossom from childhood to maturity. It explores answers to the fundamental questions that often occupy the mind of adolescents at some stage of their growth: What am I? Who am I? What is the purpose of my life? The concepts and issues associated with these questions are examined and their implications for teenagers are highlighted. The content of the book is inspired by universal spiritual principles, particularly the concepts taught by Bahá'u'lláh, the Prophet-Founder of the Bahá'í Faith. The approach and pedagogy is the result of nearly twenty years of sharing these concepts with teenagers of different age groups in the Education for Peace Program offered by the Yerrinbool Bahá'í Centre of Learning in Australia. The style of writing is simple but logical and conclusions are reached through observation and reasoning. It simulates as much as possible a tutor-tutored relationship in which the tutor facilitates learning for an individual or a small group. In summary, the book represents a manual on practical spirituality for teenagers and a workbook of activities to assist the reader to assimilate the concepts and apply them to personal situations. The book consists of four major parts: a) The emergence of human beings. This section has its focus on the evolution of life on the earth. Efforts are made in this section to distinguish between the facts and theories surrounding the concept of evolution. b) The nature of human beings. Through observation and reasoning, it is demonstrated that a pure materialistic view is far from adequate to explain all the characteristics of man. c) Cultivating inner capacities. The cultivation of inner capacities identified as a major objective of human life is emphasised and practical steps to accomplish this are explored. d) A mystical journey. The final part of the book looks into the mystical aspects of spiritual growth, which is the process of drawing closer to God through knowledge and recognition of His Manifestation, growing love of Him and serving His Cause. The book consists of 24 chapters. Each chapter starts with an introduction that highlights the key concepts addressed. The topic covered in the chapter is then explored in sections of relatively short length. The chapter then ends with a series of activities aimed at assisting the reader to assimilate the concepts. The activities are designed to stimulate thought and reflection at three levels: acquisition of knowledge provided in each chapter, analysis of this knowledge and the application of this knowledge particularly to personal situations. *A City of Marble* Kathleen S. Lamp, 2013-10-15 In *A City of Marble* Kathleen Lamp argues that classical rhetorical theory shaped the Augustan cultural campaigns and that in turn the Augustan cultural campaigns functioned rhetorically to help Augustus gain and maintain power and to influence civic identity and participation in the Roman Principate. 27 b c e 14 c e Lamp begins by studying rhetorical treatises, those texts most familiar to scholars of rhetoric, and moves on to those most obviously using rhetorical techniques in visual form. She then arrives at those objects least recognizable as rhetorical artifacts but perhaps most significant to the daily lives of the Roman people: coins, altars, wall painting. This progression also captures the development of the Augustan political myth that Augustus was destined to rule and lead Rome to greatness as a descendant of the hero Aeneas. *A City of Marble* examines the establishment of this myth in state rhetoric, traces its circulation, and finally

samples its popular receptions and adaptations In doing so Lamp inserts a long excluded though significant audience the common people of Rome into contemporary understandings of rhetorical history and considers Augustan culture as significant in shaping civic identity encouraging civic participation and promoting social advancement Lamp approaches the relationship between classical rhetoric and Augustan culture through a transdisciplinary methodology drawn from archaeology art and architectural history numismatics classics and rhetorical studies By doing so she grounds Dionysius of Halicarnassus's claims that the Principate represented a renaissance of rhetoric rooted in culture and a return to an Isocratean philosophical model of rhetoric thus offering a counterstatement to the decline narrative that rhetorical practice withered in the early Roman Empire Thus Lamp's work provides a step toward filling the disciplinary gap between Cicero and the Second Sophistic

Shields, 2009-02-02 The Christian Right is frequently accused of threatening democratic values But in *The Democratic Virtues of the Christian Right* Jon Shields argues that religious conservatives have in fact dramatically increased and improved democratic participation and that they are far more civil and reasonable than is commonly believed Shields interviewed leaders of more than thirty Christian Right organizations observed movement activists in six American cities and analyzed a wide variety of survey data and movement media His conclusions are surprising the Christian Right has reinvigorated American politics and fulfilled New Left ideals by mobilizing a previously alienated group and by refocusing politics on the contentious ideological and moral questions that motivate citizens Shields also finds that largely for pragmatic reasons the vast majority of Christian Right leaders encourage their followers to embrace deliberative norms in the public square including civility and secular reasoning At the same time Shields highlights a tension between participatory and deliberative ideals since Christian Right leaders also nurture moral passions prejudices and dogmas to propel their movement Nonetheless the Christian Right's other democratic virtues help contain civic extremism sharpen the thinking of activists and raise the level and tenor of political debate for all Americans
