Dial, 2022-10-19 Research suggests that as many as a quarter of all undergraduate students may find themselves on academic probation during their collegiate years If students on probation choose to return to their institutions the semester following notification they find themselves in a unique transitional period between poor academic performance and either dismissal or recovery Effectively supporting students through this transition may help to decrease equity gaps in higher education As recent literature implies the same demographic factors that affect students

Sherrill, Jr., 2015-02-28 The 21st North Carolina Troops 11th North Carolina Volunteers was one of only two Tar Heel Confederate regiments that in 1865 could boast From Manassas to Appomattox The 21st was the only North Carolina regiment with Stonewall Jackson during his 1862 Valley Campaign and remained with the same division throughout the war It participated in every major battle fought by the Army of Northern Virginia except the 1864 Overland Campaign when General Lee sent it to fight its own intense battles near New Bern and Plymouth This book is written from the perspective of the 1 942 men who served in the regiment and is filled with anecdotal material gleaned from more than 700 letters and memoirs In several cases it sheds new light on accepted but often incorrect interpretations of events Names such as Lee Jackson Hoke Trimble Hill Early Ramseur and Gordon charge through the pages as the Carolina regiment gains a name for itself Suffering a 50 percent casualty rate over the four years only 67 of the 920 young men and boys who began the war surrendered to Grant at its end

Fitzgerald,2017-03-13 The civil rights revolutions of the 1950s and 1960s transformed the literature on Reconstruction in America by emphasizing the social history of emancipation and the hopefulness that reunification would bring equality Much of this revisionist work served to counter and correct the racist and pro Confederate accounts of Reconstruction written in the early twentieth century While there have been modern scholarly revisions of individual states most are decades old and Michael W Fitzgerald s *Reconstruction in Alabama* is the first comprehensive reinterpretation of that state s history in over a century Fitzgerald s work not only revises the existing troubling histories of the era it also offers a compelling and innovative new look at the process of rebuilding Alabama following the war Attending to an array of issues largely ignored until now Fitzgerald s history begins by analyzing the differences over slavery secession and war that divided Alabama s whites mostly along the lines of region and class He examines the economic and political implications of defeat focusing particularly on how freed slaves and their former masters mediated the postwar landscape For a time he suggests whites and freedpeople coexisted mostly peaceably in some parts of the state under the Reconstruction government as a recovering cotton economy bathed the plantation belt in profit Later when charting the rise and fall of the Republican Party Fitzgerald shows that Alabama s new Republican government implemented an ambitious program of railroad subsidy characterized by substantial corruption that eventually bankrupted the state and helped end Republican rule He shows however that the state s freedpeople and their preferred leaders were not the major players in this arena they had other issues that mattered to them far more like public education civil rights voting rights and resisting the Klan s terrorist violence After Reconstruction ended Fitzgerald suggests that white collective memory of the era fixated on black voting big government high taxes and corruption all of which buttressed the Jim Crow order in the state This misguided understanding of the past encouraged Alabama s intransigence during the later civil rights era Despite the power of faulty interpretations that united segregationists Fitzgerald demonstrates that it was class and regional divisions over economic policy as much as racial tension that shaped the complex reality of Reconstruction in Alabama **Queer Public History** Marc Stein,2022-03-29 Over the course of the last half century queer history has developed as a collaborative project involving academic researchers community scholars and the public Initially rejected by most colleges and universities queer history was sustained for many years by community based contributors and audiences Academic activism eventually made a place
