Tolkien's Sacramental Vision Craig Bernthal, 2014-06-14 One of Tolkien's great appeals to readers is that he offers a world replete with meaning at every level To read and reread Tolkien is to share his sense of wonder and holiness to be invited into the presence of a beauty beyond the circles of the world It is to fall in love with a universe that has a beginning and an end where good and bad are not subjective choices but objective realities a created order full of grace though damaged by sin in which friendship is the seedbed of the virtues and where the greatest warriors finally become the greatest healers A correspondent once told J R R Tolkien that his work seemed illumined by an invisible lamp That lamp is the Church and its light is the imaginative sensibility that we live in a sacramental world This new book by the author of *The Trial of Man* examines in depth the influence of Catholic sacramentality on the thought and work of Tolkien with major emphasis on *The Lord of the Rings* but including his literary essays epistolary poem *Mythopoeia* short story *Leaf by Niggle* and *The Silmarillion* Here is a signal contribution to a deeper understanding of Tolkien whose mythological world is meant to recover the meaning of our own as a grace filled place pointing toward its Creator *The High Hallow: Tolkien's Liturgical Imagination* Ben Reinhard, 2025-01-01 J R R Tolkien famously described *The Lord of the Rings* as a fundamentally religious and Catholic work But while these words have been widely and enthusiastically quoted in Catholic studies of Tolkien's legendarium readers have not always paid sufficient attention to what Catholic and religious would have meant to Tolkien himself To do so is to misunderstand the full import of the phrase From his childhood as an altar server and junior inmate of the Birmingham Oratory to daily Mass with his children as an adult Tolkien's Catholic religion was at its heart a liturgical affair To be religious and Catholic in the Tolkienian sense is to be rooted in the prayer of the Church *The High Hallow* Tolkien's Liturgical Imagination takes this claim seriously *The Lord of the Rings* and Tolkien's myth as a whole is the product of an imagination seeped in liturgical prayer In the course of its argument the Ben Reinhard examines the liturgical pieties that governed Tolkien's life from childhood to old age the ways in which the liturgy colored Tolkien's theory of myth and fantasy and the alleged absence of religion in Middle earth Most importantly he shows how the plots themes and characters of Tolkien's beloved works can be traced to the patterns of the Church's liturgical year **Flora of Middle-Earth** Walter S. Among the over three thousand vascular plants Tolkien would have seen in the British Isles, the authors show why Tolkien may have selected certain plants for inclusion in his universe over others in terms of their botanic properties and traditional uses. The clear comprehensive alphabetical listing of each species along with the visual identification key of the plant drawings adds to the reader's understanding and appreciation of the Tolkien canon.

Lewis thought that he had found a door we could enter to steal past the watchful dragons of the modern person's reason by way of imaginative fiction He sought to re-introduce Christian ideas clothed in mythological garb so that in time after their affections had been stirred the explicit message about Christ might be given a fair hearing He engaged both the heart and the head In this way he pre
