In The Adventures of Tom Sawyer, Tom, the main character, starts out as a very selfish person who cares for his own needs, and not those of others. During the story, he starts to become mature. Tom changes, making him think about others, tell the truth, and care for the needs of others before his own.

To begin, Tom helped include Huck, one of his best friends, when he was being left out. The two had just previously run away to Jackson Island with their friend, Joe, where they planned to become pirates. They planned to return to their home town of St. Petersburg during their own funerals, and did so. When they returned, everyone that was at the funeral jumped for joy as they were thought dead, and celebrated by hugging Joe and Tom, but not Huck. Tom then said, "Aunt Polly, it ain't fair. Somebody's got to be glad to see Huck." (Twain, p.131) After he had said this, his Aunt agreed, and hugged Huck. This act was very unselfish, thus changing Tom for the better.

Next, Tom told the truth at Muff Potter's trial. Muff Potter was being blamed for the crime of killing Dr. Robinson, when in actuality, Injun Joe killed him. Since Potter was drunk, he believed Injun Joe when he accused him of killing Dr. Robinson at the cemetery. When all this happened, Huck and Tom were watching from behind a tree. They had come to the graveyard to burry a dead cat, and witnessed Injun Joe knock out Muff Potter, stab Dr. Robinson, and put the knife in Muff Potter's hands. During Muff Potter's trial when it seemed like he would be hung, Tom was called as witness and told the truth. He said "-And as the doctor fetched the board around and muff potter fell, Injun Joe jumped with the knife and-." (Twain, p.171) Although Injun Joe, the real culprit, was able to escape, Tom still committed an honorable deed by saving Muff Potter's life.

Lastly, Tom helped Becky when they were trapped in the cave. The two had just finished a picnic, and were part of a tour of the cave. When they were in the cave, they were so taken aback by the beauty, that they did not realize that the rest of their tour group had left. Tom quickly reacted by searching for water in case they could not get out of the cave, and found a stream. "A portion of Tom's half of the cake was left; they divided and ate it." (Twain, p.226) Tom also helped Becky stay positive, and they were able to escape the cave alive. This was extremely caring of Tom because he could have only done what was necessary to help him survive, but he also helped Becky, which saved them both.

In conclusion, Tom showed great improvement throughout the book. From being a selfish character, Tom has thought about others and told the truth, which are very great achievements for him. By doing these things, Tom greatly benefited the lives of others, just as he did to his own life.
