Technocracy and the Epistemology of Human Behavior Paul Gunn, 2022-11-10 In *Power Without Knowledge A Critique of Technocracy* 2019 Jeffrey Friedman presented a sweeping reinterpretation of modern politics and government as technocratic even in many of its democratic dimensions Building on a new definition of technocracy as governance aimed at solving social and economic problems Friedman showed that the epistemic demands that such governance places on political elites and ordinary people alike may be overwhelming if technocrats fail to attend to the ideational heterogeneity of the human beings whose control is the object of technocratic power Yet a recognition of ideational heterogeneity considerably complicates the task of predicting behavior which is essential to technocratic control as Friedman demonstrated with pathbreaking critiques of the homogenizing strategies of neoclassical economics positivist social science behavioral economics and populist democratic politics In *Technocracy and the Epistemology of Human Behavior* thirteen political theorists including Friedman himself debate the implications of *Power Without Knowledge* for social science modern governance the politics of expertise post structuralism anarchism and democratic theory and Friedman responds to his critics with an expansive defense of his vision of contemporary politics and his political epistemology of ideationally diverse human beings This book was originally published as a special issue of the *Critical Review*

Awapara,2023-01-01 This book answers why anti trade forces in developing countries sometimes fail to effectively exert pressure on their governments The backlash against globalization spread across several Latin American countries in the 2000s yet a few countries such as Peru doubled down on their bets on free trade by signing bilateral agreements with the US and the EU This study uses evidence from three Latin American countries Peru Argentina and Bolivia to suggest that geography can play a significant role in shaping trade preferences and undermining the formation and clout of distributional coalitions that seek protectionism Because trade liberalization can have uneven distributional impacts along regional lines trade liberalization losers can find themselves in unfavorable conditions to associate and engage in collective action Under these circumstances few coalitions emerge to battle for protection in the policy arena and when they do geographic distance from decision makers in the capital city can be a significant barrier to realizing their interests As a result even where a majority of the population living in regions that have not benefitted from trade elect a leftist president trade reform reversal will not occur unless protectionist interests are close to the capital city The contrast between Peru on one side and Argentina and Bolivia on the other highlights the powerful influence geography can have on reversing trade policy or preserving the status quo

Politics after Violence Hillel Soifer,Alberto Vergara,2019-01-14 Between 1980 and 1994 Peru endured a bloody internal armed conflict with some 69 000 people killed in clashes involving two insurgent movements state forces and local armed groups In 2003 a government sponsored Truth and Reconciliation Committee reported that the conflict lasted longer affected broader swaths of the national territory and inflicted higher costs in both human and economic terms than any other conflict in Peru s history Of those killed 75 percent were speakers of an indigenous language and almost 40 percent were among the poorest and most rural members of Peruvian society These unequal impacts of the violence on the Peruvian people revealed deep and historical disparities within the country This collection of original essays by leading international experts on Peruvian politics society and institutions explores the political and institutional consequences of Peru s internal armed conflict in the long 1980s The essays are grouped into sections that cover the conflict itself in historical comparative and theoretical perspectives its consequences for Peru s political institutions its effects on political parties across the ideological spectrum and its impact on public opinion and civil society This research provides the first systematic and nuanced investigation of the extent to which recent and contemporary Peruvian politics civil society and
