Bardach, Kathleen Gleeson, 2003-05-01 In 1941 as a Red Army soldier fighting the Nazis on the Belarussian front Janusz Bardach was arrested court martialled and sentenced to ten years of hard labor Twenty two years old he had committed no crime He was one of millions swept up in the reign of terror that Stalin perpetrated on his own people In the critically acclaimed *Man Is Wolf to Man* Bardach recounted his horrific experiences in the Kolyma labor camps in northeastern Siberia the deadliest camps in Stalin's gulag system In this sequel Bardach picks up the narrative in March 1946 when he was released He traces his thousand mile journey from the northeastern Siberian gold mines to Moscow in the period after the war when the country was still in turmoil He chronicles his reunion with his brother a high ranking diplomat in the Polish embassy in Moscow his experiences as a medical student in the Stalinist Soviet Union and his trip back to his hometown where he confronts the shattering realization of the toll the war has taken including the deaths of his wife parents and sister In a trenchant exploration of loss post traumatic stress syndrome and existential loneliness Bardach plumbs his ordeal with honesty and compassion affording a literary window into the soul of a Stalinist gulag survivor *Surviving Freedom* is his moving account of how he rebuilt his life after tremendous hardship and personal loss It is also a unique portrait of postwar Stalinist Moscow as seen through the eyes of a person who is both an insider and outsider Bardach's journey from prisoner back to citizen and from labor camp to freedom is an inspiring tale of the universal human story of suffering and recovery

Book cover A Prospering Society John Hare,2011 This book seeks to explore the changing nature of English society through a case study of countryside and town in southern England during the period from c 1380 to c 1520 It explores the influence of landscape and population on the agriculture of Wiltshire the regional patterns of arable and pastoral farming and the growing contrast between the large scale mixed farming of the chalklands and the family farms of the claylands It examines the changing situation of the rural tenant population as it reacted to the greater opportunities available in the land market During this period Wiltshire became one of the great cloth producing counties of England as reflected in its rising taxable wealth Such economic expansion generated jobs both within the industry and beyond stimulating the market for food services and manufactured goods Salisbury was one of the greatest cities in the kingdom and below this was a hierarchy of interesting lesser towns But such growth generated its own problems more and more people became dependent on the cloth trade and particularly on exporting cloth if exports fell as during the mid fifteenth century crisis they suffered As scholars are increasingly aware the later Middle Ages was a period of considerable change and this study contributes to debates about the nature of both change and continuity at a national level It will also be of value to local historians interested in one of the most important periods in Wiltshire s history BLACKWELL S

Linderkamp, 2012-12-06 Decision making in modern obstetrics and perinatology is controlled by a variety of different factors but there is little doubt that in industrialized countries one of the most powerful single factors is the concern and fear of causing permanent brain damage in the unborn and newborn The dramatic increase in the rates of abdominal deliveries in many parts of the world is certainly rooted to a substantial part in the obstetrician's concern not so much about possible perinatal death but more so about permanent brain damage in surviving children This trend has been accelerated by the increasing number of litigations in connection with brain damage observed in many societies This problem itself has many aspects but it seems evident that litigation justified or unjustified is one modern expression of the human and social tragedy inflicted on individuals and families by the birth of a brain damaged child The medical social and human importance of the problem is in sharp contrast to the relative lack of scientific knowledge available This became very clear when the National Institutes of Health published the excellent review in 1985 on Prenatal and Perinatal Factors Associated with Brain Disorders and its editor J M West of Malatia Sarkis J. Leading Seaman Charlie Erswell saw much more than his fair share of action during the Second World War He was present at the 1942 landing in North Africa Operation TORCH D Day and the liberation of Norway But his main area of operations was that of the Arctic Convoys escorting merchant ships taking essential war supplies to the Russian ports of Murmansk and Archangel In addition to contending with relentless U boat and Luftwaffe attacks crews endured the extreme sea conditions and appalling weather This involved clearing ice and snow in temperatures as low as minus thirty degrees Celsius No wonder Winston Churchill described it as the worst journey in the world Fortunately Charlie who served on two destroyers HMS Milne and Savage kept a record of his experiences and is alive today to describe them His story published to coincide with the 80th Anniversary of the first convoy is more than one man s account It is an inspiring tribute to his colleagues many of whom were killed in action No one reading Surviving The Arctic Convoys could fail to be moved by the bravery and endurance of these outstanding men

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
