Labour and Economic Change in Southern Africa c.1900-2000 Rory Pilossof, Andrew Cohen, 2021-06-03 This book explores the social and economic development of Zimbabwe Zambia and Malawi over the course of the twentieth century These three countries have long shared and interconnected pasts All three were drawn into the British Empire at a similar time and the formation of the ill fated Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland formally linked these countries together for a decade in the mid twentieth century This formal political relationship created dynamics that resulted in yet closer economic and social links After Federation the economic realities of industry transport and labour supplies meant that these three countries continued to be intricately interconnected Yet despite these connected pasts comparative work on the economic histories of Malawi Zambia and Zimbabwe and how these change over time is rare This book addresses the gap by providing the first comprehensive collection of labour and census data across the twentieth century for these three countries The different economic models and performances of these states offer good comparison allowing researchers to look at different models of development and how these played out over the long term The book provides data on population growth and change industrial and occupational structure and the various shifts in what the economically active population did It will be useful for historians economists development studies scholars and non governmental organisations working on twentieth century and contemporary southern Africa Agriculture, Autonomous Development, and Prospects for Industrialization in Africa Emmanuel Ndhlovu, 2025-03-06 The book investigates the intersection of agriculture and development in Africa and how it impacts rural industrialisation prospects It provides a comprehensive view of the position of agriculture in African socio economic activities and the agricultural sector s potential as the source for continental development and industrialisation prospects Significant research has been done on African development with a focus placed on the problematic role played by slavery colonialism and later by incompetent African leaders who failed to steer development of the type that delivers a progressive sustained and sustainable transformation of lives and societies There is limited focus on the possibility of agriculture being the potential basis of African development and the chance for industrialisation This is a matter of concern considering the dominance of agriculture as a livelihood and income source for many people on the continent In contributing to the debate on development in Africa this book aims to show how agriculture can serve as the basis for African development and industrialisation This will be achieved by i providing a detailed historical description of the position of agriculture in African socio economic activities ii outlining the trajectory of African development with a focus on agriculture innovation and mechanisation iii identifying challenges to the development of African agriculture iv exploring the opportunities for agricultural development in Africa and v providing practical and policy recommendations to improve African agriculture and make it the engine for development and industrialisation Utilising a multidisciplinary approach which combines political economy social policy financial inclusion and empowerment approaches the book also shows how

These four theories help situate the COVID 19 pandemic and its impacts on the urban poor in the theoretical foundations that raise issues of how the poor are affected by disease health pandemics due to their living conditions Uniquely the authors use remote ethnography tools such as rich texts video diaries and photo uploads to provide evidence based stories of how COVID 19 mobility restrictions have affected poor urbanites in Harare The book concludes that the COVID 19 pandemic mandatory lockdowns have deepened social and spatial inequality among the urban poor threatening their right to the city The socio economic impacts can upsurge poverty increase unemployment and the risks of hunger and food insecurity reinforce existing inequalities and break social harmony in the cities even past the COVID 19 pandemic period These socioeconomic impacts must be considered to make just cities for all from a right to the city perspective The authors recommend that mandatory COVID 19 lockdowns should not only be treated as a law and order operation but as a medical intervention to stem the spread of the virus backed by measures to safeguard the livelihoods of the urban poor while also protecting the economy This means governments should provide social safety nets to informal sector operators whose income generating activities are affected the most during the time of emergencies like COVID 19 Planners and policymakers should re envision pandemic resilient cities that are just equitable resilient and sustainable
