Utopia Thomas More (Sanctus), Desiderius Erasmus Rotterdamius, 1999 **Utopia** Thomas More, 1999-01-15 Wootton's translation brings out the liveliness of More's work and offers an accurate and reliable version of a masterpiece of social theory. His edition is further distinguished by the inclusion of a translation of Erasmus's *The Sileni of Alcibiades*, a work very close in sentiment to *Utopia* and one immensely influential in the sixteenth century. This attractive combination suits the edition especially well for use in Renaissance and Reformation courses as well as for Western Civilization survey courses. Wootton's Introduction simultaneously provides a remarkably useful guide to anyone's first reading of More's mysterious work and advances an original argument on the origins and purposes of *Utopia*, which no one interested in sixteenth-century social theory will want to miss.

Between Utopia and Dystopia Hanan Yoran, 2010-04-19 The figure of the intellectual looms large in modern history and yet his or her social place has always been full of ambiguity and ironies. *Between Utopia and Dystopia* is a study of the movement that created the identity of the universal intellectual: Erasmian humanism. Focusing on the writings of Erasmus and Thomas More, Hanan Yoran argues that in contrast to other groups of humanists, Erasmus and the circle gathered around him generated the social space, the Erasmian Republic of Letters, that allowed them a considerable measure of independence. The identity of the autonomous intellectual enabled the Erasmian humanists to criticize established customs and institutions and to elaborate a reform program for Christendom. At the same time, however, the very notion of the universal intellectual presented a problem for the discourse of Erasmian humanism itself. It distanced the Erasmian humanists from concrete public activity and as such clashed with their commitment to the ideal of an active life. Furthermore, citizenship in the Republic of Letters threatened to lock the Erasmian humanists into a disembodied intellectual sphere, thus undermining their convictions concerning intellectual activity and the production of knowledge. *Between Utopia and Dystopia* will be of interest to scholars and students interested in Renaissance humanism, early modern intellectual and cultural history, and political thought. It also has much to contribute to debates over the identity, social place, and historical role of intellectuals.

Shakespeare's Folly Sam Hall, 2016-06-23 This study contends that folly is of fundamental importance to the implicit philosophical vision of Shakespeare's drama. The discourse of folly's wordplay, jubilant ironies, and vertiginous paradoxes furnish Shakespeare with a way of understanding that lays bare the hypocrisies and absurdities of the serious world. Like Erasmus More and Montaigne before him, Shakespeare employs folly as a mode of understanding that does not arrogantly insist upon the veracity of its own claims; a fool's truth, after all, is spoken by a fool. Yet as this study demonstrates, Shakespearean folly is not the sole preserve of professional jesters and garrulous clowns; for it is also apparent on a thematic, conceptual, and formal level in virtually all of his plays. Examining canonical histories, comedies, and tragedies, this study is the first to either contextualize Shakespearean folly within European humanist thought or to argue that Shakespeare's philosophy of folly is part of a subterranean strand of Western philosophy which itself reflects upon the folly of the wise. This

navigate an interdisciplinary landscape by placing Kierkegaard's passionate thought in conversation with the writings of Georg Lukács, Carl Schmitt, Walter Benjamin and Theodor Adorno. At the heart of the book's argument is the concept of indirect politics, which names a negative space between methods, concepts and intellectual acts in the work of Kierkegaard as well as marking the dynamic relations between Kierkegaard and the aforementioned thinkers. Kierkegaard's indirect politics is a set of masks that displaces identities from one field to the next: theology masks politics, law masks theology, political theory masks philosophy and psychology masks literary approaches to truth. As reflected in Lukács, Schmitt, Benjamin and Adorno, this book examines how Kierkegaard's indirect politics sets into relief three significant motifs: intellectual non-conformism, indirect communication in and through ambiguous identities and negative dialectics.

He holds degrees from Aarhus University, Denmark (PhD), University College Dublin (MA) and Trinity College Dublin (1999). He was visiting lecturer at the European College of Liberal Arts in Berlin (2007-2011) and Lady Margaret Hall, University of Oxford (2010) and was a guest scholar at the Søren Kierkegaard Research Centre in Copenhagen (2007 and 2005) and the Kierkegaard Library at St Olaf College, Minnesota (2005). He has written extensively on Kierkegaard and also published articles on Nietzsche, Pessoa, Joyce, Shakespeare and Schmitt.

Reinventions of the Novel, 2021-11-01. The history of the novel is a story of perpetual change so that its identity still remains open to question. The sixteen articles in *Reinventions of the Novel* investigate connections, differences and similarities in the novel around the world for the past three hundred years. Rather than searching for the essence of the genre, they look for the formal and thematic patterns on which the novel thrives, considering such matters as tradition and modernity, realism, rhetoric and identity, tableau and spatiality and wondering whether epic and avant-garde are not quite contradictory terms. Close readings combined with historical overviews and theoretical discussions open up new constellations in the history of the novel.
