

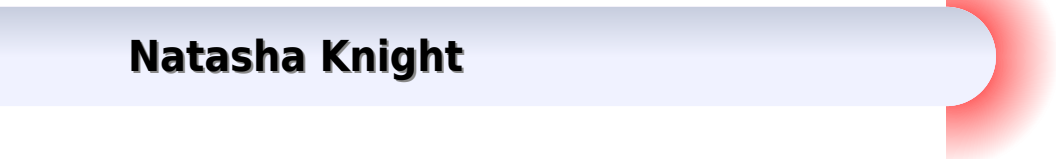

The Life of Permafrost Pey-Yi Chu, 2020-12-07 In the Anthropocene the thawing of frozen earth due to global warming has drawn worldwide attention to permafrost Contemporary scientists define permafrost as ground that maintains a negative temperature for at least two years But where did this particular conception of permafrost originate and what alternatives existed The Life of Permafrost provides an intellectual history of permafrost placing the phenomenon squarely in the political social and material context of Russian and Soviet science Pey Yi Chu shows that understandings of frozen earth were shaped by two key experiences in the Russian Empire and the Soviet Union On one hand the colonization and industrialization of Siberia nourished an engineering perspective on frozen earth that viewed the phenomenon as an aggregate physical structure ground On the other a Russian and Soviet tradition of systems thinking encouraged approaching frozen earth as a process condition and space tied to planetary exchanges of energy and matter Aided by the US militarization of the Arctic during the Cold War the engineering view of frozen earth as an obstacle to construction became dominant The Life of Permafrost tells the fascinating story of how permafrost came to acquire life as Russian and Soviet scientists studied named and defined it

 Ilya Vinkovetsky, 2011-04-06 From 1741 until Alaska was sold to the United States in 1867 the Russian empire claimed
 territory and peoples in North America In this book Ilya Vinkovetsky examines how Russia governed its only overseas colony
 illustrating how the colony fit into and diverged from the structures developed in the otherwise contiguous Russian empire
 Russian America was effectively transformed from a remote extension of Russia s Siberian frontier penetrated mainly by
 Siberianized Russians into an ostensibly modern overseas colony operated by Europeanized Russians Under the rule of the
 Russian American Company the colony was governed on different terms than the rest of the empire a hybrid of elements
 carried over from Siberia and imported from rival colonial systems Its economic labor and social organization reflected
 Russian hopes for Alaska as well as the numerous limitations such as its vast territory and pressures from its multiethnic
 residents it imposed This approach was particularly evident in Russian strategies to convert the indigenous peoples of
 Russian America into loyal subjects of the Russian Empire Vinkovetsky looks closely at Russian efforts to acculturate the
 native peoples including attempts to predispose them to be more open to the Russian political and cultural influence through
 trade and Russian Orthodox Christianity Bringing together the history of Russia the history of colonialism and the history of

 the arts witness such an extraordinary upsurge of musical creativity and the prominence of musicians in the cultural elite
 This is one of the questions that Kiril Tomoff seeks to answer in *Creative Union* the first book about any of the professional
 unions that dominated Soviet cultural life at the time Drawing on hitherto untapped archives he shows how the Union of
 Soviet Composers established control over the music profession and negotiated the relationship between composers and the
 Communist Party leadership Central to Tomoff s argument is the institutional authority and prestige that the musical
 profession accrued and deployed within Soviet society enabling musicians to withstand the postwar disciplinary campaigns

that were so crippling in other artistic and literary spheres Most accounts of Soviet musical life focus on famous individuals or the campaign against Shostakovich's *Lady Macbeth* and Zhdanov's postwar attack on musical formalism Tomoff's approach while not downplaying these notorious events shows that the Union was able to develop and direct a musical profession that enjoyed enormous social prestige The Union's leadership was able to use its expertise to determine the criteria of musical value with a degree of independence Tomoff's book reveals the complex and mutable interaction of creative intelligentsia and political elite in a period hitherto characterized as one of totalitarian control

Threads of Empire Charles Steinwedel, 2016-05-09 A history and analysis of Bashkiria and its transformation into a Russian imperial region over the course of three and a half centuries *Threads of Empire* examines how Russia's imperial officials and intellectual elites made and maintained their authority among the changing intellectual and political currents in Eurasia from the mid sixteenth century to the revolution of 1917 The book focuses on a region 750 miles east of Moscow known as Bashkiria The region was split nearly evenly between Russian and Turkic language speakers both nomads and farmers Ufa province at Bashkiria's core had the largest Muslim population of any province in the empire The empire's leading Muslim official the mufti was based there but the region also hosted a Russian Orthodox bishop Bashkirs and peasants had different legal status and powerful Russian Orthodox and Muslim nobles dominated the peasant estate By the twentieth century industrial mining and rail commerce gave rise to a class structure of workers and managers Bashkiria thus presents a fascinating case study of empire in all its complexities and of how the tsarist empire's ideology and categories of rule changed over time An original and well researched study of the incorporation of the Bashkir lands and their transformation into a Russian imperial region over the course of three and a half centuries Steinwedel argues that the history of Bashkiria exposes a number of the empire's achievements as a multiethnic society He draws out both important shifts and abiding continuities in the history of the region and by employing a multi dimensional approach covering a range of intersecting topics provides a fuller appreciation for the region He also does a nice job pointing out the useful commonalities and differences between the Bashkir lands and other parts of the empire making a compelling case for Bashkiria's importance for understanding larger processes Willard Sunderland author of *Taming the Wild Field: Colonization and Empire on the Russian Steppe* With its solid grounding in Russian archival and printed sources and its sophisticated comparative approach Steinwedel's work will serve as a point of departure for historians of the Russian Empire and will become a book of reference for any future study of empires in global history *American Historical Review* Steinwedel's book is both a skilful exercise in local and regional history and an important contribution to the history of Imperial Russia as a whole *Slavonic and East European Review*
