I believe that ISE should have the opportunity to expand on the knowledge I was introduced to as "Math Week". I am excited to be able present to that learning system as the E Symposium on Industrial and Systems Engineering through the integration of the academic knowledge and my personal/industry-related studies as research in an interdisciplinary environment.
