Barksdale, 2025-01-14 As the COVID 19 virus swept across the nation in spring 2020 infection and hospitalization rates in states like West Virginia remained relatively low By that July each of Appalachia s 423 counties had recorded confirmed cases The coronavirus pandemic has taken an enormous toll on the health of individuals and institutions throughout the region a stark reminder that even isolated rural populations are subject to historical biological ecological and geographical factors that have continually created epidemics over the past millennia In *Appalachian Epidemics From Smallpox to COVID 19* scholars from diverse disciplinary backgrounds assess two centuries of public health emergencies and the subsequent responses This volume peers into the trans Appalachian South s experience with illness challenging the misconception that rurality provides protection against maladies In addition to surveying the impact of influenza polio and Lyme disease outbreaks *Appalachian Epidemics* addresses the less understood social determinants of health The effects of the opioid crisis and industrial coal mining complicate the definition of disease and illuminate avenues for responding to future public health threats From the significance of regional stereotypes to the spread of misinformation and the impact of racism and poverty on public health policy *Appalachian Epidemics* makes clear that many of the natural political and socioeconomic forces currently shaping the region s experiences with COVID 19 and other crises have historical antecedents *As Wolves upon a Sheep Fold* Aaron D. Purcell, 2023-08-18 William S Newton 1823 1882 served the Union primarily as an assistant surgeon with the 91st Ohio Volunteer Infantry but also spent a few months as acting surgeon with the 2nd Virginia Cavalry US Toward the end of the war he was promoted to surgeon for the 193rd Ohio Volunteer Infantry Newton s units fought in the Appalachian Highlands mostly in Virginia and West Virginia He treated wounded soldiers after significant battles including Opequon and Cedar Creek In May 1864 following the Battle of Cloyd s

Mountain John Hunt Morgan's Raiders captured Newton and other medical personnel. After three weeks, Newton and his fellow prisoners were given the option of either treating Confederate soldiers or going to Libby Prison; they chose the latter. Newton spent only three days at Libby Prison before being released, but the experience took a significant toll on his health. The letters in this volume, addressed mostly to Newton's wife Frances, provide a window into fighting in the Appalachian borderlands where the differences between battle, guerilla warfare, and occupation were often blurred. As a noncombatant, the doctor observed life beyond troop movements and the brutality of war. Newton's detailed letters cover his living quarters, race relations, transportation, and communication, the comfort of a good meal, and the antics of his teenage son Ned. This book provides new insights into the medical and social history of the war, the war in Western Virginia, local and regional history, the perspective of a noncombatant life on the home front, and the porous lines between home and battlefield. **Villainous**

In chilling detail, Hasegawa describes the weapons proposed and prepared for use during the war and introduces the people behind the concepts. Although many of the ideas for chemical weapons had a historical precedent, most of the suggested agents were used in industry or medicine, and their toxicity was common knowledge. Proponents, including a surprisingly high number of civilian physicians, suggested a wide variety of potential chemical weapons, from liquid chlorine in artillery shells to cayenne pepper solution sprayed from fire engines. Some weapons advocates expressed ethical qualms, while others were silent on the matter or justified their suggestions as necessary under current circumstances. As Hasegawa explains, bureaucrats in the war departments of both armies either delayed or rejected outright most of these unusual weapons, viewing them as unneeded or unworkable. Nevertheless, many of the proposed armaments presaged the widespread use of chemical weapons in the twentieth and twenty-first centuries. For example, while Civil War munitions technology was not

advanced enough to deliver poison gas in artillery shells as some advocates suggested the same idea saw extensive use during World War I Similarly forms of an ancient incendiary weapon Greek fire were used sparingly during the Civil War and appeared in later conflicts as napalm bombs and flamethrowers Especially timely with today's increased chemical threats from terrorists and the alleged use of chemical agents in the Syrian Civil War Villainous Compounds Chemical Weapons and the American Civil War reveals the seldom explored chemical side of Civil War armaments and illuminates an underappreciated stage in the origins of modern chemical warfare Edward A. Wild and the African Brigade in the Civil War Frances H. Casstevens, 2015-08-31 Edward Wild the controversial Union general who headed the all black African Brigade in the Civil War was one of the most loved and most hated figures of the 19th century The man was neither understood nor appreciated by military or civilian black or white Northerner or Southerner After enlisting at the outbreak of the war Wild was promoted to Brigadier General and placed in charge of the United States Colored Troops In fulfilling his assignment to free slaves and gain recruits he took three women as hostages and ordered a great deal of property destruction He freed hundreds perhaps thousands of slaves and settled them safely on Roanoke Island Wild then not only recruited the newly freed blacks but trained them and gave them the opportunity to prove their worth in battle Nobody it seems was happy about serving with them but the African Brigade performed courageously in several battles Wild did some inexplicable things Were his actions typical of the 19th century or did he act outside the norm Was the criticism he suffered from his fellow Union officers valid or was it due to personality conflicts Did he deserve to be arrested court martialed and even wiped from the history books or was he the victim of discrimination This work draws its answers from extensive research and includes many rare letters to and from Wild including one from one of the North Carolinian hostages
