## Child's History of the World Chapter 20: Wise Men and Other Ideas

### Overview

Philip, the king of Macedonia, aimed to rule Greece but faced opposition from Demosthenes, who practiced speaking with pebbles in his mouth to improve his speeches against Philip. Despite Demosthenes' efforts, Philip successfully conquered Greece but was killed before he could invade Persia, leaving his kingdom to his son, Alexander. At just twenty years old, Alexander became king and received a special horse named Bucephalus for his cleverness. He was educated by Aristotle, who wrote influential books used as school texts for centuries, having been taught by Plato, a former pupil of Socrates.

2. What did Demosthenes do to improve his speaking skills?
3. Who became king of Macedonia and Greece after Philip's death?
