because the grading scale is adjusted to take into account the performance of the total AP U S History test taker population When used with the corresponding chart the scoring method we present here will strongly approximate the score you would receive if you were sitting for the actual AP U S History exam

$$\frac{\text{DBQ} + \text{Essay 1} + \text{Essay 2}}{3} = \text{raw score}$$
round to the nearest whole number You may want to give your essays three different grades such as a 13 10 and an 8 and then calculate your score three ways as if you did
