Argumentative Synthesis Essay. This essay type aims to persuade the reader to adopt a particular point of view on a topic. It requires the writer to synthesize information from different sources to support their argument with evidence, examples, and reasoning.

Review Synthesis Essay. It is a critical analysis of a topic, idea, or concept. The writer must synthesize information from different sources to provide a comprehensive and objective evaluation of the topic. The focus is on providing a detailed analysis of the sources, including their strengths and weaknesses.
