Over the past years few African countries have been the focus of discussions and analyses generating a vast array of literature as much as Zimbabwe. The socioeconomic and political crises since the turn of the century have deeply transformed the country from the ideals of a vibrant freshly independent nation just two decades earlier. These transformations have necessitated the call for the restructuring of Zimbabwean society polity and economy. But this literature remains exclusively within the realm of academic thinking and theorising with no concerted effort to move beyond this by explicitly drawing out the policy implications. *Beyond the Crises: Zimbabwe's Prospects for Transformation* is a welcome addition to the academic and policy literature with a much broader and all embracing focus in terms of policy interventions. By focusing on different aspects of social and economic justice Murisa and Chikweche go beyond initiating a broad discussion on these two key pillars of human development with a view to suggesting possible future directions of practical solutions and policy development for the attainment of inclusive social and economic justice for Zimbabweans.

Preventing Violent Conflict in Africa Y. Mine, F. Stewart, S. Fukuda-Parr, T. Mkandawire, 2013-10-17. Horizontal inequalities are root causes of violent conflict in Africa. Yet people take actions not because of statistical data on inequalities of which they might not be aware but because of injustices they perceive. This volume analyses the results of original surveys with over 3 000 respondents in African cities and towns exposing clear discrepancies between objective inequalities and people's subjective perceptions. The contributors examine experiences in country pairs and probe into the reasons why neighbouring countries sharing common historical traits sometimes took contrasting pathways of peace and violent conflict. Combining quantitative analysis and qualitative anatomy of historical experiences of conflict and reconciliation in Rwanda Burundi Ghana Cote d'Ivoire South Africa Zimbabwe Uganda Tanzania Kenya and Nigeria the study brings forward a set of policy recommendations for development practitioners. Social movements and civic organizations often face profound strategy dilemmas that can hamper their effectiveness and prevent them from contributing to transformative change and peace In Zimbabwe two particular dilemmas have fed into and fueled destructive processes of political polarization dividing society leadership and decision makers well beyond its borders As conceptualized in this study the first is whether to prioritize political or economic rights in efforts to bring about nation wide transformative change rights or redistribution The second is whether and how to work with government and or donors given their political economic and social agendas participation or resistance This book investigates these issues through two social movement organizations the National Constitutional Assembly and the Zimbabwe National War Veterans Association and the movements they led to achieve constitutional change and radical land redistribution Through in depth case study analysis and peace and conflict impact assessment spanning the years 1997 2010 lessons are drawn for activists practitioners policy makers and scholars interested in depolarizing concepts underpinning polarizing discourses transcending strategy dilemmas and understanding how social action can better contribute to transformative change and peace **The Land Reform Deception** Charles Laurie, 2016-02-01

The Land Reform Deception looks at a particularly contentious period in Zimbabwe s recent history from 2000 2008 when the government seized commercial farms using illegal and violent methods against a largely unarmed population of farmers and farm workers Robert Mugabe s government began the seizures on a small targeted scale in an effort to suppress political opposition groups but they soon escalated into an out of control frenzy targeting all farms in the country The state claimed that the seizures occurred in response to a public cry for land redistribution and to rectify colonial era injustices and were part of a structured land reallocation program Yet land was often distributed ad hoc to those with little or no farming experience As a result agricultural output contracted and inflation and unemployment rose dramatically in what became a social and economic disaster for the country In The Land Reform Deception Charles Laurie asks why the state would target its own agricultural industry using such violent methods and risk such dire consequences He also seeks to uncover the major actors and their motivations and strategies Laurie argues that the seizure of the most valuable farms was largely carried out by politically influential individuals for financial and political gain rather than to address historical injustices In fact he finds that the scale on which the farm invasions were carried out and the violent methods used were never part of a planned government land policy Indeed Laurie shows that Mugabe initially opposed the seizures knowing that they would wreck the economy only to later support them in order to appease his supporters and retain political power Incorporating unprecedented empirical evidence gathered from in depth interviews with senior politicians members of the secretive Central Intelligence Organization the military and police along with farmers and farm workers who were targeted during the invasions The Land Reform Deception strips away official explanations and delves into the political and economic drivers that triggered the seizure of commercial farms in Zimbabwe Land, Poverty

Kamete, 2002 This is a study of the terrain of urban governance using areas of Zimbabwe's biggest city Harare as case studies It presents and discusses sets of perceptions of poverty and the poor which influence policy development and decisionmaking among urban governors Kamete shows the effects of positive as well as negative perceptions of the poor He also problematizes more conventional understandings of poverty and includes into his own conceptual understanding dimensions of deficient access to participation and citizenship He shows that the relationship between power and powerlessness among the poor is much more complex than is sometimes assumed
