- Covers all aspects of the work such as the content and structure.
- Can include a recommendation or a star rating.

Information Report

- Gives factual information and details about a specific topic.
- Topic can be living or non-living.
- Uses present tense forms and words such have, can, are and not.
- It doesn't use opinions or guesses.
- Lots of research on the topic is done first.

Recount

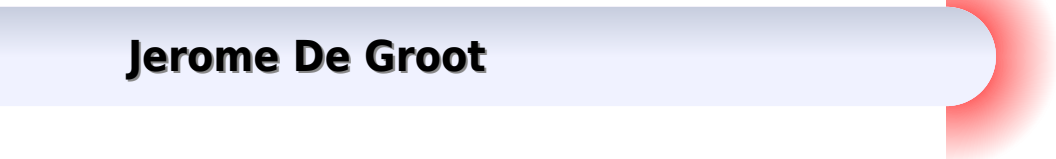
- Retells something that has already happened in the past.
