

Antigens: *Anything that stimulates an immune response.*

For example: *Bacteria, Viruses, dirt, dust, allergens, etc.*

_____Lymphatic system_____: *It is a separate circulatory system that transports interstitial fluid from all around cells back to the blood's circulatory system. Body movements circulate interstitial fluid.*

Function of Lymphatic system: *Transport nutrients and wastes. Transport antigens and pathogens to Lymph nodes.*

Lymph Nodes: *Filter interstitial fluid. Swollen "glands" mean you are fighting an infection.*

Adenoids and Tonsils: *Lymph nodes that help fight infections in the respiratory tract*

_____Peyer's Patches_____: *Lymphatic tissue clustered around small intestine to monitor pathogens in digestive system. Contributes to Oral-immune tolerance to the foods we eat.*

Oral-Immune Tolerance: *Local and System-wide tolerance to foods eaten.*

Dysbiosis: *Loss of beneficial microbial and increase in pathobionts*

Pathobionts: *Symbiotic bacteria becomes pathogenic under certain conditions. (e.g. some E.coli)*

White blood cells formed in _____Bone Marrow_____, _____Thymus_____ and _____Spleen_____ and many mature in _____Thymus_____.

_____Spleen_____: *Recycles Red Blood Cells, makes / stores some White Blood Cells and Platelets. Without a Spleen, patients have increased risk for serious infections (e.g. Pneumonia, Meningitis, Septicemia, but do well otherwise.*

Innate Immune Response: *Attack any antigen (not specific) that is not recognized as "self".*

First non-specific defense against Infection and Disease: *External defenses*

a. Skin, Exoskeleton, or other body covering keeps things out.

b. Tears, Sweat, and Saliva have enzyme Lysozyme that kills bacteria.

_____Dermscidin_____: *is an antimicrobial protein secreted by Human Eccrine sweat glands onto the skin as a part of the non-specific defense (innate) response of the immune system.*

c. Mucus washes pathogens away from body.

d. Stomach acids can kill many pathogens.

Second non-specific defense against Infection and Disease: *Generalized attack cells.*

a. Natural Killer Cells: *WBCs that attack Bacteria, Viruses, and Cancer cells.*

Perforins: *Proteins that make holes in cells.*

Granzymes: *Proteins that kill cancer / infected cells with Apoptosis.*

Cytokines: *Proteins that control the immune response.* **Interferon:** *Cytokine made by infected cells to warn other cells.*

b. Macrophages: *Giant WBCs that can "eat" whole bacteria and protists.*

c. _____Eosinophils_____: *White blood cells create inflammation. Excess linked to Crohn's disease, IBD, and Asthma.*

Third non-specific defense against Infection and Disease: *Hormonal response*

Inflammation: *Redness, Swelling, and Heat.*

Pyroptosis: *Death of infected cells by inflammation / cell-bursting.*

Why do you respond to infection or injury with inflammation?

1. Trap antigens at site of injury

2. Immobilize injured joints.
