These comprise Enforcement of environmental and social safeguards Tanzania has made progress in implementing the Environmental Management Act by ensuring greater compliance with the Environmental Impact Assessment regulations although exceptions exist in the construction sector and mining legislation that often enables the government to circumvent important land tenure safeguards Incentives for sustainable investments in the legal framework A lack of incentives exists despite the creation of the Tanzania Investment Centre the adoption of an Investment Guide in 2013 and the incorporation of sustainability considerations into laws and policies governing investments in the agriculture energy and forestry and mining sectors Land tenure security Tanzania s land law framework now includes formal recognition of customary title and the reservation of land under the category of village land exclusively for Tanzanians although improvements are still needed in terms of processes of consultation and compensation Public awareness and lack of access to information Awareness of natural resources and investment policies legislation and regulations is generally low amongst rural communities as well as Ward executive officers village leaders and village land committee members Rural radio represents their most important source of information

Gender and the Judiciary in Africa Gretchen Bauer, Josephine Dawuni, 2015-10-30 Between 2000 and 2015 women ascended to the top of judiciaries across Africa most notably as chief justices of supreme courts in common law countries like Ghana Nigeria Sierra Leone Gambia Malawi Lesotho and Zambia but also as presidents of constitutional courts in civil law countries such as Benin Burundi Gabon Niger and Senegal Most of these appointments was a first in terms of the gender of the chief justice At the same time women are being appointed in record numbers as magistrates judges and justices across the continent While women s increasing numbers and roles in African executives and legislatures have been addressed in a burgeoning scholarly literature very little work has focused on women in judiciaries This book addresses the important issue of the increasing numbers and varied roles of women judges and justices as judiciaries evolve across the continent Scholars of law gender politics and African politics provide overviews of recent developments in gender and the judiciary in nine African countries that represent north east southern and west Africa as well as a range of colonial experiences postcolonial trajectories and legal systems including mixes of common civil customary or sharia law In the process each chapter seeks to address the following questions What has been the historical experience of the judicial system in a given country from before colonialism until the present What is the current court structure and where are the women judges justices magistrates and other women located What are the selection or appointment processes for joining the bench and in what ways may these help or hinder women to gain access to the courts as judges and justices Once they become judges do women on the bench promote the rights of women through their judicial powers What are the challenges and obstacles facing women judges and justices in Africa Timely and relevant in this era in which governmental accountability and transparency are essential to the consolidation of democracy in Africa and when women are accessing significant leadership positions across the continent this book considers the substantive and symbolic representation of women s interests by women judges and the wider implications of their presence for changing institutional norms and advancing the rule of law and human rights

The Delusion of Knowledge Transfer Susanne Koch, Peter

Weingart, 2016-12-13 With the rise of the knowledge for development paradigm expert advice has become a prime instrument of foreign aid At the same time it has been object of repeated criticism the chronic failure of technical assistance a notion under which advice is commonly subsumed has been documented in a host of studies Nonetheless international organisations continue to send advisors promising to increase the effectiveness of expert support if their technocratic recommendations

are taken up This book reveals fundamental problems of expert advice in the context of aid that concern issues of power and legitimacy rather than merely flaws of implementation Based on empirical evidence from South Africa and Tanzania the authors show that aid related advisory processes are inevitably obstructed by colliding interests political pressures and hierarchical relations that impede knowledge transfer and mutual learning As a result recipient governments find themselves caught in a perpetual cycle of dependency continuously advised by experts who convey the shifting paradigms and agendas of their respective donor governments For young democracies the persistent presence of external actors is hazardous ultimately it poses a threat to the legitimacy of their governments if their policy making becomes more responsive to foreign demands than to the preferences and needs of their citizens
