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ICCWS 2016 11th International Conference on Cyber Warfare and Security Dr Tanya Zlateva and Professor Virginia Greiman, 2016 The 11th International Conference on Cyber Warfare and Security ICCWS 2016 is being held at Boston University Boston USA on the 17-18th March 2016. The Conference Chair is Dr Tanya Zlateva and the Programme Chair is Professor Virginia Greiman, both from Boston University. ICCWS is a recognised Cyber Security event on the International research conferences calendar and provides a valuable platform for individuals to present their research findings, display their work in progress and discuss conceptual and empirical advances in the area of Cyber Warfare and Cyber Security. It provides an important opportunity for researchers and managers to come together with peers to share their experiences of using the varied and expanding range of Cyberwar and Cyber Security research available to them. The keynote speakers for the conference are Daryl Haegley from the Department of Defense DoD who will address the topic Control Systems Networks What's in Your Building and Neal Ziring from the National Security Agency who will be providing some insight to the issue of Is Security Achievable A Practical Perspective. ICCWS received 125 abstract submissions this year. After the double-blind peer review process, there are 43 Academic Research Papers, 8 PhD papers, Research papers, 7 Masters and 1 work in progress papers published in these Conference Proceedings. These papers represent work from around the world including Australia, Canada, China, Czech Republic, District of Columbia, Finland, France, Israel, Japan, Lebanon, Netherlands, Pakistan, Russian Federation, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, UK, USA.

Environmental Impact Statement for Construction Permit for the Northwest Medical Isotopes Radioisotope Production Facility Final Report Nuclear Regulatory Commission (U.S.), 2017-05-16. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has prepared this environmental impact statement (EIS) in response to an application submitted by Northwest Medical Isotopes LLC (NWMI) for a construction permit for the NWMI medical radioisotope production facility. The EIS includes the analysis that evaluates the environmental impacts of the proposed action and considers the following alternatives to the proposed action: 1. the no action alternative, i.e. the construction permit is denied; 2. one alternative site; and 3. two alternative technologies. After weighing the environmental, economic, technical, and other benefits against environmental and other costs and considering reasonable alternatives, the NRC staff's recommendation, unless safety issues mandate otherwise, is to issue a construction permit to NWMI. The NRC staff based its recommendation on the following factors: the NRC staff's review of the NWMI Environmental Report and responses to requests for additional information; the NRC staff's consultation with Federal, State, and local agencies and Tribal officials; the NRC staff's independent environmental review; and the NRC staff's consideration of public comments.
