

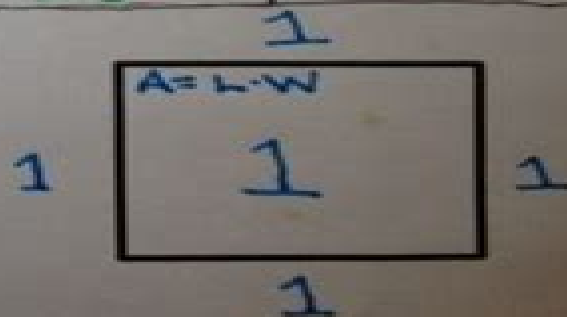

extreme weather events are the main determinants of land degradation and that land degradation smallholder farms income and outmigration are highly correlated In addition they portray a new migration dynamic from rural areas in the highlands directly to urban centers in the US and demonstrate that the poverty marginalization context contributes substantially to global migration flows Despite the harsh labour conditions and the poor economic basis in the area temporary Guatemalan workers rapidly replace the out migrated local labour force on coffee plantations and small farms giving evidence of their life at the fringe of the globalized economy
