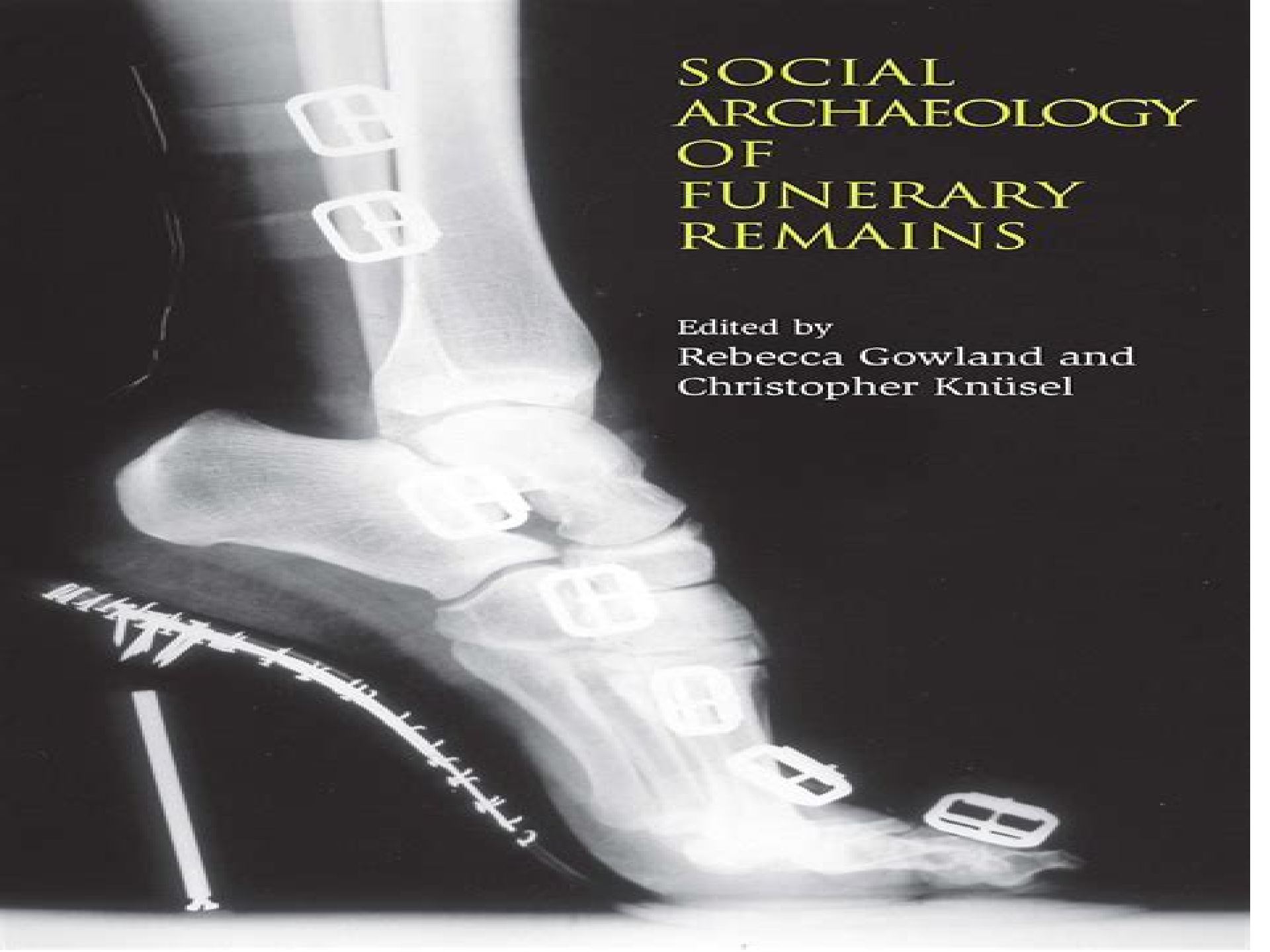

An Archaeology of Prehistoric Bodies and Embodied Identities in the Eastern Mediterranean Maria Mina, Sevi Triantaphyllou, Yiannis Papadatos, 2016-10-11 In the long tradition of the archaeology of the eastern Mediterranean bodies have held a prominent role in the form of figurines frescos or skeletal remains and have even been responsible for sparking captivating portrayals of the Mother Goddess cult the elegant women of Minoan Crete or the deeds of heroic men Growing literature on the archaeology and anthropology of the body has raised awareness about the dynamic and multifaceted role of the body in experiencing the world and in the construction performance and negotiation of social identity In these 28 thematically arranged papers specialists in the archaeology of the eastern Mediterranean confront the perceived invisibility of past bodies and ask new research questions Contributors discuss new and old evidence they examine how bodies intersect with the material world and explore the role of body situated experiences in creating distinct social and other identities Papers range chronologically from the Palaeolithic to the Early Iron Age and cover the geographical regions of the Aegean Cyprus and the Near East They highlight the new possibilities that emerge for the interpretation of the prehistoric eastern Mediterranean through a combined use of body focused methodological and theoretical perspectives that are nevertheless grounded in the archaeological record

The Bioarchaeology of Classical Kamarina Carrie L. Sulosky Weaver, 2015-09-23 Choice Outstanding Academic Title Sicily was among one of the first areas settled during the Greek colonization movement making its cemeteries a popular area of study for scholars of the classical world Yet these studies have often considered human remains and burial customs separately In this seminal work Carrie Sulosky Weaver synthesizes skeletal material and ritual data to reconstruct the burial customs demographic trends state of health and ancestry of Kamarina a city state in Sicily Using evidence from 258 recovered graves from the Passo Marinaro necropolis Sulosky Weaver suggests that Kamarineans whose cultural practices were an amalgamation of both Greek and indigenous customs were closely linked to their counterparts in neighboring Greek cities The orientations of the graves positions of the bodies

and the types of items buried with the dead including Greek pottery demonstrate that Kamarineans were full participants in the mortuary traditions of Sicilian Greeks Likewise cranial traits resemble those found among other Sicilian Greeks Interestingly evidence of cranial surgery magic and necrophobic activities also appeared in Passo Marinaro graves another example of how Greek culture influenced the city An overabundance of young adult skeletal remains combined with the presence of cranial trauma and a variety of pathological conditions indicates the Kamarineans may have been exposed to one or more disruptive events such as prolonged wars and epidemic outbreaks Despite the tumultuous nature of the times the resulting portrait reveals that Kamarina was a place where individuals of diverse ethnicities and ancestries were united in life and death by shared culture and funerary practices

The Archaeology of Death in Roman Syria Lidewijde de Jong, 2017-07-20 In the first centuries of the Common Era an eclectic collection of plain and embellished underground and aboveground tombs filled the cemeteries of the Roman province of Syria Its inhabitants used rituals of commemoration to express messages about their local identity family and social position while simultaneously ensuring that the deceased was given proper burial rites In this book Lidewijde de Jong investigates these customs and the belief systems that governed the choices made in the commemoration of Syrian men women and children Presenting the first all inclusive overview of the archaeology of death in Roman Syria this book combines spatial analysis of cemeteries with the study of funerary architecture decoration and grave goods as well as information about the deceased provided by sculptural epigraphic and osteological sources It sheds a new light on life and death in Syria and offers a novel way of understanding provincial culture in the Roman Empire

becoming increasingly important in the field of bioarchaeology providing valuable sources of data where small diverse samples impede populational approaches
