Introduction

The conceptualization and implementation of national policy in the communication/information sector becomes increasingly important with each advance towards an integrated international information network. Nations have sought to elaborate policies that will protect and extend possibilities for sovereign economic, political and cultural development. The specific characteristics of self-reliant or autonomous models for development vis-à-vis the information sector vary significantly. But key components include protection from the incursion of foreign transnational corporations (TNCs) and promotion of indigenous hardware and software production capability. The critique of this model offered here focuses on the complexity and contradictions in the process of national policy implementation.¹

The literature addressed to the potential created by information technologies for self-reliant, autonomous or sovereign development has located and exposed a significant barrier to effective national policy implementation. Analysis has revealed that TNCs located in 'centre' nations including the US, Japan and Western Europe, which promote the benefits of the information revolution, attempt to homogenize and integrate the global economic and cultural community to increase sales and profit.
