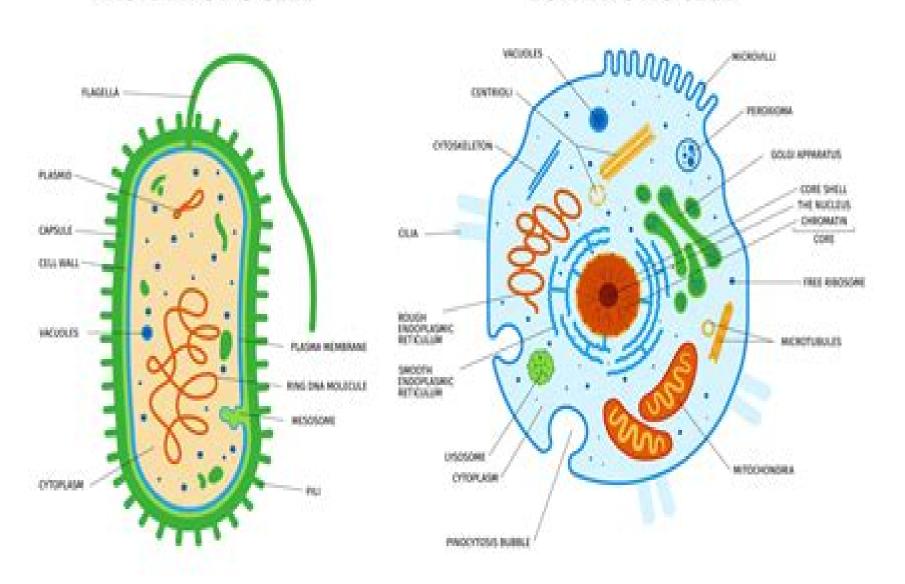

global analyses to probe the cellular proteome the repertoire of the actual effector molecules. One general strategy has been to take advantage of improved separations technologies as well as greatly improved mass spectrometry resolution to quantitatively or comparatively measure hundreds or thousands of proteins Proteins from multiple conditions i e mock infected and infected may be differentially labelled by various techniques such as 2D DIGE ICAT iTRAQ SILAC with 180 during peptide preparation and or by various other methods and then compared to measure comparative alterations in the levels of proteins induced by the virus infection Such analyses have also been extended by using label free methods for more efficient multiplexing applications and or by examining specific protein modifications.
