Introduction & research methods

Introduction

- *Scientific investigation of how our thinking, feelings & behaviour are influenced by the actual, imagined or implied presence of others*
- Includes:
 - Observable activity
 - Psychological dimensions

Characteristics

1. The individual in the social context as the level of analysis
2. Examines internal psychological states as well as overt behaviour
3. Uses scientific methods to investigate questions

SP & related areas

1. Sociology
 - Level of analysis → SP = individual perspective, S = behaviour of collectives etc.
 - Methodology → SP = experiments, S = qual/quant
2. Clinical psychology
 - Focus → CP = abnormal focus, SP = "normal" person
3. Personality psychology
 - Stability → SP = individuals are a product of situation, PP = stable personalities

SP & common sense

- The "knew-it-all-along" phenomenon
- Common sense seems to explain many social psychological findings after the fact
 - But how does one distinguish common sense facts from common sense myths?
- Unlike common sense, social psychology uses the scientific methods to put its theories to the test

- A young discipline = rapid growth, change, development

Early influences

- Behaviourism – SP would only flourish if it become experimental
- Rise of fascism – more American dominance

1930s-1950s

- W/WII prompted... look at slides

1960s – mid 1970s

- Milgram's famous obedience experiments
- Period of expansion and enthusiasm
- Also a time of crisis and heated debate → strong reactions against the laboratory experiment as the dominant research method

Mid 1970s – 1990s

- Crisis led to a stronger discipline
