One has but to turn to the first chapter of Genesis to find in the margin the date 4004 B C recorded with all confidence as the year of man's first appearance on the globe One finds there too a brief but comprehensive account of the manner of his appearance as well as of the creation of the earth itself his abiding place Until about half a century ago as has just been said the peoples of our portion of the globe
