Death's Men Denis Winter, 2014-10-23 *Death's Men* is the classic bestselling story of the First World War as told by the soldiers themselves reissued for the 2014 Centenary Millions of British men were involved in the Great War of 1914-1918 But both during and after the war the individual voices of the soldiers were lost in the collective picture Men drew arrows on maps and talked of battles and campaigns but what it felt like to be in the front line or in a base hospital they did not know Civilians did not ask and soldiers did not write *Death's Men* portrays the humble men who were called on to face the appalling fears and discomforts of the fighting zone It shows the reality of the First World War through the voices of the men who fought A raw haunting read that puts you directly into the shoes of the men who rushed to volunteer at the start of the war Guardian An engrossing view of what it was like to live in the trenches go on leave get wounded et cetera and features voice after voice from the ranks Telegraph Denis Winter was born in 1940 and read history at Pembroke College Cambridge *Death's Men* was first published in 1978 to critical and popular acclaim This was followed by his book *The First of the Few* Fighter Pilots of the First World War

Death, Men, and Modernism Ariela Freedman, 2014-04-08 *Death Men and Modernism* argues that the figure of the dead man becomes a locus of attention and a symptom of crisis in British writing of the early to mid twentieth century While Victorian writers used dying women to dramatize aesthetic structural and historical concerns modernist novelists turned to the figure of the dying man to exemplify concerns about both masculinity and modernity Along with their representations of death these novelists developed new narrative techniques to make the trauma they depicted palpable Contrary to modernist genealogies the emergence of the figure of the dead man in texts as early as Thomas Hardy's *Jude the Obscure* suggests that World War I intensified but did not cause these anxieties This book elaborates a nodal point which links death masculinity and modernity long before the events of World War I

The Bravest Scout at Gallipoli Ryan Butta, 2024-07-30 Harry Freame was the first Australian to win the Distinguished Conduct Medal at Gallipoli Raised as a samurai he risked his life again and again to scout the beaches and hills of the battlefield reporting invaluable intelligence back to his officers and relieving stranded soldiers who otherwise would surely have died Some say he should have got the VC but didn't because he was half Japanese a fact he tried hard to conceal After the war Harry real name Henry Wykeham Koba Freame became a soldier settler and champion apple grower But when Japan emerged as a perceived threat to Australia Harry was recruited into Australian intelligence to spy on the Japanese community in Sydney Before Japan's entry into World War II Australia opened a diplomatic legation in Tokyo and Harry was sent as a translator but his real role was a spy Extraordinarily his cover was leaked by the Australian press and the Japanese secret police tried to assassinate him not long after his arrival in Tokyo in 1941 Harry died back in Australia a few weeks later but his sacrifice has never been acknowledged by Australia Until now Featuring never before seen material
