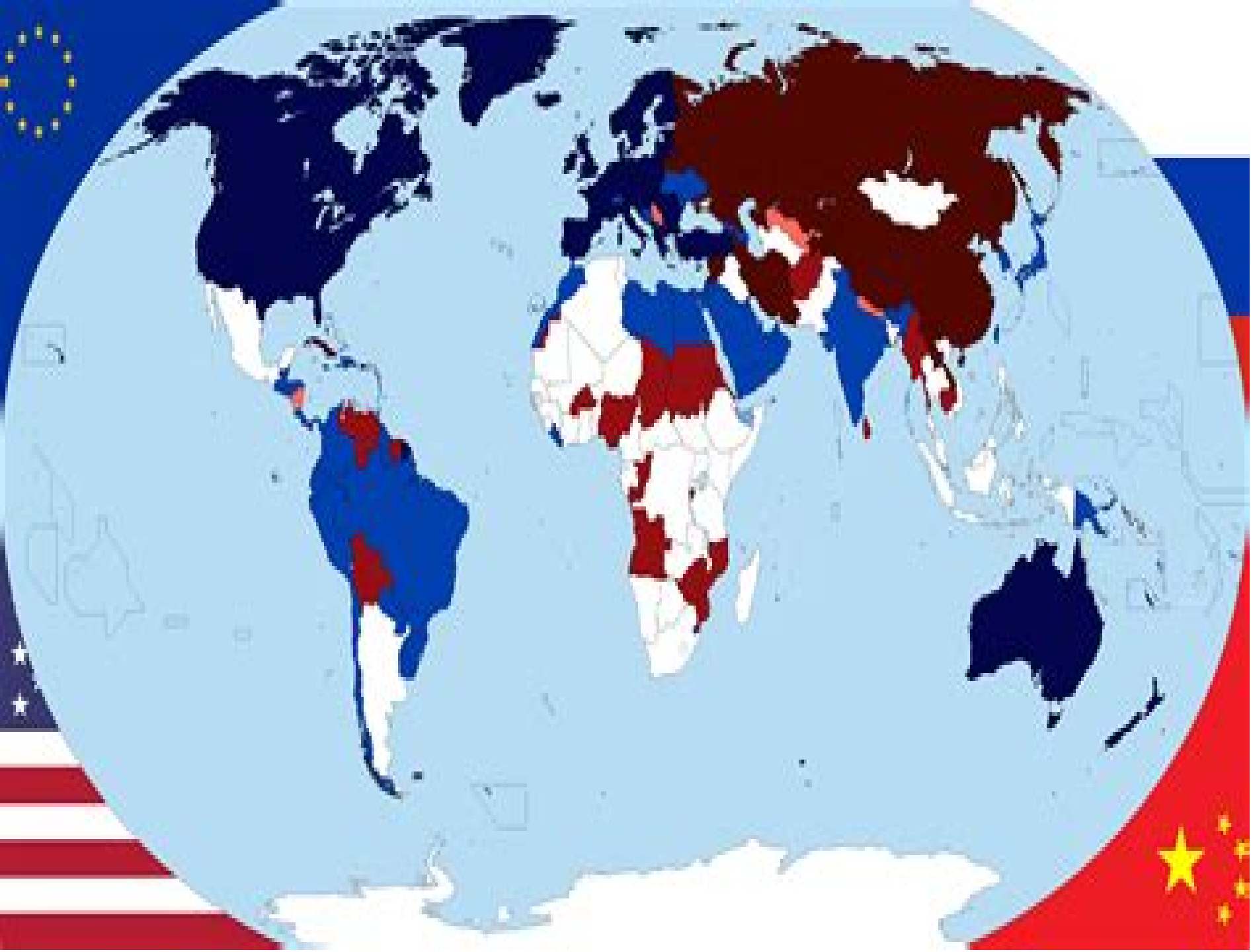




The Cold War

needed Acheson's boss Harry Truman earns just over four columns while Truman's opponent in the infamous 1948 general election Thomas Dewey barely rates one column Each entry is factual and concise The entry on Martin Luther King Jr mentions his early life and education his adherence to Gandhi's policy of nonviolence the March on Washington and his assassination in Tennessee avoiding the various controversies surrounding both King's life and death Sometimes the generally objective tone of the work is missing as when for example it defines communism as paradoxical and self-defeating Black and white photographs enhance the text and the index is detailed This volume is a worthy addition to the cold war reference shelf Its coverage of people places and events that might be ignored in works with a more international perspective makes it a good starting point for anyone interested in an American focus Recommended for high school public and academic libraries RBB Copyright © American Library Association All rights reserved
