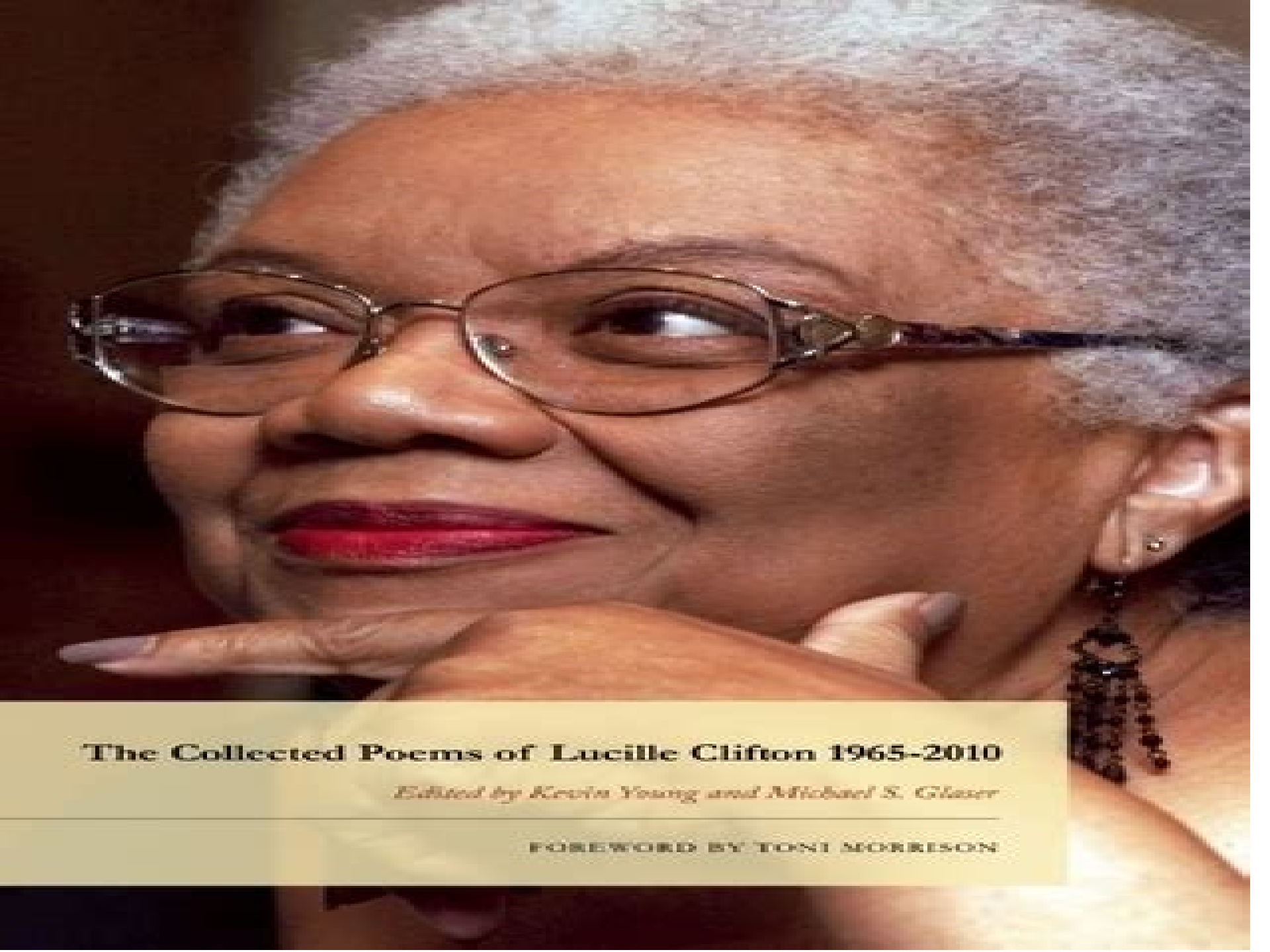

recognize his experiments as poems and might signal their awkward confusion upon opening the book by looking round for poetry as if seeking it elsewhere *Look Round for Poetry* transforms Wordsworth's idiomatic expression into a methodological charge By placing tropes and figures common to Romantic and Post Romantic poems in conjunction with contemporary economic technological and political discourse *Look Round for Poetry* identifies poetry's untimely echoes in discourses not always read as poetry or not always read poetically Once one begins looking round for poetry McGrath insists one might discover it in some surprising contexts In chapters that spring from poems by Wordsworth Lucille Clifton John Keats and Percy Bysshe Shelley McGrath reads poetic examples of understatement alongside market demands for more the downturned brow as a figure for economic catastrophe Romantic cloud metaphors alongside the rhetoric of cloud computing the election of the dead as a poetical and not just a political act and poetic investigations into the power of prepositions as theories of political assembly For poetry to retain a vital power McGrath argues we need to become ignorant of what we think we mean by it In the process we may discover critical vocabularies that engage the complexity of social life all around us **Oral**

times subtly at other times overtly about who we are who God is and how we should live together David M Stark looks at the way many Confederate monuments provided ongoing opportunities for commemorative speeches and ceremonies that would entrench racist and white supremacist ideologies in the American South Stark examines key speeches and proclamations given around monuments to the Lost Cause such as Julian Carr's Silent Sam speech 1913 and Archer Anderson's speech at the dedication of a monument to Robert E Lee 1890 reading these as theological and homiletic moments Stark then moves on to construct a homiletic that can confront such monuments and the racist preaching ideologies around them In developing this counter homiletic Stark analyzes the preaching strategies written into Confederate monuments and highlights best practices from recent counter proclamations that deconstruct the troubling rhetoric and theology of Confederate monument dedication speeches Finally Stark presents insights from naming commission reports and clergy interviews about the values mission and leadership needed to work for ongoing change

Thick Tressie McMillan Cottom, 2019-01-08 *Through a Small Ghost* Chelsea Dingman, 2020-02-15 This collection of poems speaks to the grief and trauma associated with stillbirth and infertility But more than that these poems are concerned with how both parents deal with this trauma without letting it tear them or their relationship apart There are threads beneath the surface of the poems that speak to the inequality in these relationships and in the male female dynamic whether this inequality is perceived or real Dingman also questions the perception of reality itself when dealing with the traumatized mind Dingman asks the difficult questions that surround child rearing Are the children themselves everything the parents had hoped for Is there still something missing She explores the invisibility of the mother after she has children as well as what a woman is willing to sacrifice in terms of body country and relationship Set against changing political climates in Florida Canada and Denmark these poems navigate the geopolitical differences that influence the experience of parenting
