The Dark Bible Alison Knight, 2022-08-25 The Dark Bible explores early modern England's interactions with difficult aspects of the Bible. For the early modern reader, although the Bible was understood to be perfect, sufficient and transcendent, indeed the Protestant Reformation required it, it was not always experienced as such. While traditional interpretive precepts such as the claim that all dark passages could be read in the light of clear ones were frequently recited by early modern commentators, their actual encounters with the darkness of the Bible suggest that writers, commentators and translators were often deeply uncomfortable with the disjunction between what the Bible should be and what it actually was. The Dark Bible investigates writers and translators' attempts to explain, accommodate, circumvent and repair problematic texts across a range of genres and contexts. It charts early modern English use of biblical scholarship in vernacular culture and investigates how vernacular writing in various genres could give voice to questioning and confused biblical interactions. The Dark Bible demonstrates that early modern writers and critics engaged extensively with the Bible's difficulties, attempting to circumvent and repair problematic texts and otherwise reconcile the darkness of the Bible with theories of the Bible's perfection and clarity.

Re-imagining the 'Dark Continent' in fin de siècle Literature Robbie McLaughlan, 2012-10-01 Maps the fin de siècle mission to open up the Dark Continent. Although nineteenth-century map makers imposed topographic definition upon a perceived geographical void, writers of Adventure fiction and other colonial writers continued to nourish the idea of a cartographic absence in their work. This study explores the effects of this epistemological blankness in fin de siècle literature and its impact upon early Modernist culture through the emerging discipline of psychoanalysis and the debt that Freud owed to African exploration. The chapters examine representations of Black Africa in missionary writing and Rider Haggard's narratives on Africa, cartographic tradition in Conrad's *Heart of Darkness* and Jung's *Memories, Dreams, Reflections* and mesmeric fiction such as Richard Marsh's *The Beetle*, Robert Buchanan's *The Charlatan* and George du Maurier's *Trilby*. As Robbie McLaughlan demonstrates, it was the late Victorian best seller which merged an arcane Central African imagery with an interest in psychic phenomena.

In the Dark Room Rosanna Maule, Julie Beaulieu, 2009 This book examines Duras's contribution to contemporary cinema. The dark room in the collection's title refers to one of Duras's metaphors for the writing process: *la chambre noire* as the solitary space of literary creation, the place where she struggles to project her internal shadow onto the blank page. The dark room is also a metaphor for the film theater and, by extension, for the filmic experience. Duras rejected conventional forms of cinematic address that encourage the spectator to develop a positive identification with the film's diegesis and narrative.
