Songs Beyond the Kalevala Anna-Leena Siikala, Sinikka Vakimo, 1994 The title of this volume refers to the tradition of rune singing which was the foundation for Elias Lonnrot's compilation of the Kalevala epic The interest in the epic poetry chosen as the basis for the Kalevala both gave birth to Finnish folkloristics as well as constituted its most important area from the 18th to the beginning of the 20th century The comparative research method created by Julius Krohn which was perfected and formulated into the historical geographical method by his son Kaarle Krohn formed the foundation for Kalevala poetry research in the beginning of the last century A research method derived from evolutionist and diffusionist cultural theories sought answers to questions concerning the age and character of the poetry These questions had a central importance in the creation of the young nation state's cultural capital The typological research established in the 1930s and the textual critique of the 1950s did not question these basic premises although the theoretical centres of attention had shifted Historical types of examination preserved their status because a rune tradition which contained pre Christian mythology and ancient ethnographic elements was considered to provide a glimpse into the past of the non literate Finnish Karelian culture

The Ivory Tower, Harry Potter, and Beyond Lana A. Whited, 2024-02-26 In her follow up to *The Ivory Tower* and *Harry Potter* Lana A Whited has compiled a new collection of essays analyzing the books films and other media by J K Rowling This includes pieces on the Harry Potter books and movies *Fantastic Beasts* and *Where to Find Them* films *The Cursed Child* play as well as her writing outside the wizarding universe such as *The Ickabog* *The Casual Vacancy* and the *Cormoran Strike* series Many of the chapters explore works that influenced the Harry Potter series including Classical epic Shakespearian comedy and tragedy and Arthurian myth In addition to literary comparison the volume delves into topics like political authoritarianism distrust of the media racial and social justice and developments in fandom It's fair to say that much has changed in regard to Harry Potter and J K Rowling scholarship in the twenty years since the first volume's publication While it was once considered a

universally beloved book series the relationship between HP and its fans has grown more complicated in recent years As its readers have grown older and Rowling s reputation has wavered in the public eye Whited and her contributors consider the complicated legacy of Harry Potter and its author and explore how the series will evolve in the next twenty years

Varieties of Liberalization and the New Politics of Social Solidarity Kathleen Thelen,2014-03-31 This book examines contemporary changes in labor market institutions in the United States Germany Denmark Sweden and the Netherlands focusing on developments in industrial relations vocational education and training and labor market policy It finds that there are in fact distinct varieties of liberalization associated with very different distributive outcomes Most scholarship equates liberal capitalism with inequality and coordinated capitalism with higher levels of social solidarity However this study explains why the institutions of coordinated capitalism and egalitarian capitalism coincided and complemented one another in the Golden Era of postwar development in the 1950s and 1960s and why they no longer do so Contrary to the conventional wisdom this study reveals that the successful defense of the institutions traditionally associated with coordinated capitalism has often been a recipe for increased inequality due to declining coverage and dualization Conversely it argues that some forms of labor market liberalization are perfectly compatible with continued high levels of social solidarity and indeed may be necessary to sustain it

Tales of magic, tales in print Willem De Blecourt, 2018-04-30 Since the beginning of the nineteenth century folklorists and the general public in their wake have assumed the orality of fairy tales Only lately have more and more specialists been arguing in favour of at least an interdependence between oral and printed distribution of stories This book takes an extreme position in that debate as far as Tales of magic is concerned the initial transmission proceeded exclusively through prints From a historical perspective this is the only viable approach the opposite assumption of a vast unrecorded and thus inaccessible reservoir of oral stories presents a horror vacui Only in the course of the nineteenth century when folklorists started collecting in the field and asked their informants for fairy tales was this particular genre incorporated into a then feeble oral tradition Even then story tellers regularly reverted to printed texts Every recorded fairy tale can be shown to be dependent on previous publications or to be a new composition constructed on the basis of fragments of stories already in existence Tales of magic tales in print traces the textual history of a number of fairy tale clusters linking the findings of literary historians on the sixteenth to eighteenth centuries to the material collected by nineteenth and twentieth century field workers While it places fairy tales as a genre firmly in a European context it also follows particular stories in their dispersion over the rest of the world
