According to the experts of [professional Report Writing UK](#), report is primarily used to convey information. The most important facts should be conveyed to the reader and put into context. Depending on the purpose of the report, it differs in a few ways. As a journalistic form of representation, it is derived from the news, while in other professional fields and science it is more similar to the protocol.

Most people, however, are more familiar with the journalistic text form, because it is mainly used in daily newspapers, but also online magazines. The aim of the report is to summarize the most important facts of an event and convey them in a way that is understandable for the reader. The journalistic text form is derived from the message or a report. Accordingly, a report should be written factually.

Different types of reports:

Because not only journalists have to convey facts to the readers, but also in other professions and also in school and studies you have to present results from time to time and formulate them clearly and understandably for everyone.
