DEFINITION

James Porter (1992) defined a discourse community as: "...a local and temporary constraining system, defined by a body of texts (or more generally, practices) that are unified by a common focus. A discourse community is a textual system with stated and unstated conventions, a vital history, mechanisms for wielding power, institutional hierarchies, vested interests, and so on."

CHARACTERISTICS

1. A broadly agreed upon set of common public goals.
2. Mechanisms of communication among the members.
3. The use of participatory mechanisms for providing information and feedback.
4. The use of one or more genres in communication.
5. Acquired specific lexis.
6. Members with a suitable degree of relevant content and expertise.

Landmark Essays on ESL Writing Tony Silva, Paul Kei Matsuda, 2013-10-31 In recent years the number of nonnative speakers of English in colleges and universities in North America has increased dramatically. As a result more and more writing teachers have found themselves working with these English as a Second Language (ESL) students in writing classes that are designed primarily with monolingual native English speaking students in mind. Since the majority of institutions require these students to enroll in writing courses at all levels it is becoming increasingly important for all writing teachers to be aware of the presence and special linguistic and cultural needs of ESL writers. This increase in the ESL population has over the last 40 years been paralleled by a similar growth in research on ESL writing and writing instruction research that writing teachers need to be familiar with in order to work effectively with ESL writers in writing classrooms of all levels and types. Until recently however this body of knowledge has not been very accessible to writing teachers and researchers who do not specialize in second language research and instruction. This volume is an attempt to remedy this problem by providing a sense of how ESL writing scholarship has evolved over the last four decades. It brings together 15 articles that address various issues in second language writing in general and ESL writing in particular. In selecting articles for inclusion the editors tried to take a principled approach. The articles included in this volume have been chosen from a large database of publications in second language writing. The editors looked for works that mirrored the state of the art when they were published and made a conscious effort to represent a wide variety of perspectives, contributions, and issues in the field. To provide a sense of the evolution of the field this collection is arranged in chronological order.

This book is divided into thematic sections which deal with issues central to English in the eighteenth century. These include linguistic ideology and the grammatical tradition, the contribution of women to the writing of grammars, the interactions of writers at this time and how politeness was encoded in language including that on a regional level. The contributions also discuss how language was seen and discussed in public and how grammarians, lexicographers, journalists, pamphleteers and publishers judged on going change. The novel insights offered in this book extend our knowledge of the English language at the onset of the modern period.

College Writing and Beyond Anne Beaufort, 2008-02-06 Composition research consistently demonstrates that the social context of writing determines the majority of conventions any writer must observe. Still most universities organize the required first year composition course as if there were an intuitive set of general writing skills usable across academic and work world settings. In *College Writing and Beyond: A New Framework for University Writing Instruction* Anne Beaufort reports on a longitudinal study comparing one student's experience in FYC in history in engineering and in his post college writing. Her data illuminate the struggle of college students to transfer what they learn about general writing from one context to another. Her findings suggest ultimately not that we must abolish FYC but that we must go beyond even genre theory in reconceiving it. Accordingly Beaufort would argue that the FYC course should abandon its hope to teach a sort of general academic discourse and instead should systematically teach strategies of responding to contextual elements that impinge on the writing situation. Her data

urge attention to issues of learning transfer and to developmentally sound linkages in writing instruction within and across disciplines Beaufort advocates special attention to discourse community theory for its power to help students perceive and understand the context of writing
