Chapter 1

1. Describe the setting of the story.

The story is set in Maycomb, Alabama. It is a tired, country town. Grass grows on the sidewalks, porches come into bad shape in the rain. The time period of the story is not directly stated, but it is sometime soon after FDR's inaugural presidential address when he claimed that we, as a nation, have "nothing to fear but fear itself." This speech was in 1933.

2. From whose point of view of the story is the story told? Name him/her. What do you know about him/her so far?

The story is told from Scout's point of view. She is 3 years old. She has a brother named Jem, age 9. Her dad is Atticus, and she has a cook named Calpurnia. She struggles to behave well for Calpurnia, and she is frequently in trouble with her. She seems to know a lot about Maycomb and her family.

Dill is Charles Baker Harris, age 6. He is the nephew of Rachel Harrisford, the woman who lived next door to the Finches. He is a small kid and is from Meridian, Mississippi. He had no father and he comes to spend his summers with his aunt in Maycomb.

5. What has happened to Boo Radley? Why are the kids so fascinated with the house?

Boo Radley is also known as Arthur Radley. He got in trouble with the law when he was young; he was hanging out with the wrong crowd, some of the Cunningham from Old Sarum. When he got in trouble, his father locked him in the house instead of sending him off to an industrial reform school with the other boys. He has become a recluse and he doesn't come out of the house. No one goes near the Radley house; it remained constantly shut up and they see little activity from the house, despite Maycomb's social culture.
