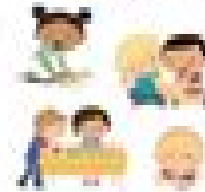

When I need the toilet I have to stop what I am doing and go to the toilet.



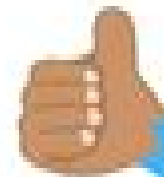
