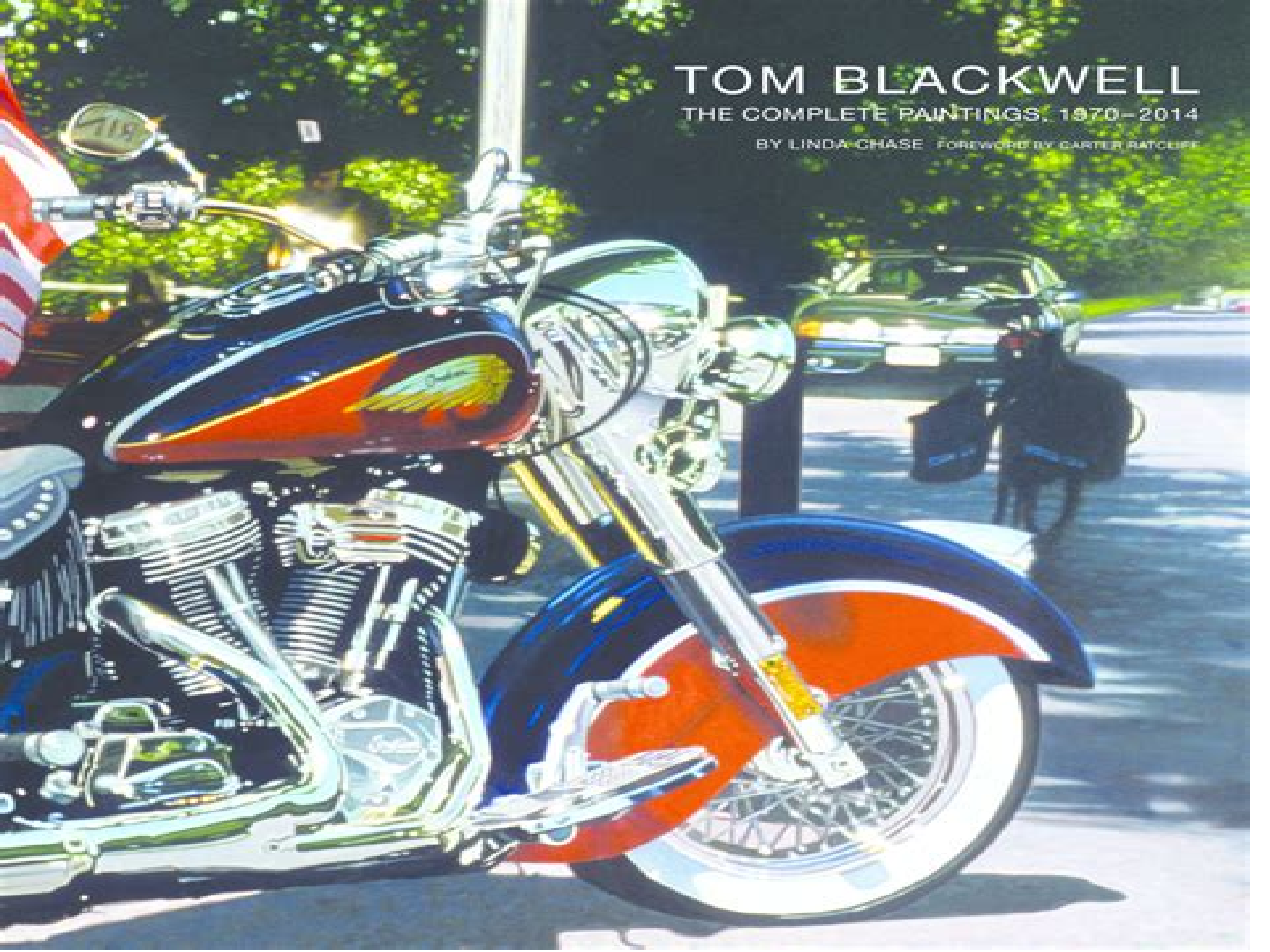

Tom Blackwell Linda Chase, 2016 Tom Blackwell born 1938 is primarily known for his work in photorealism a movement characterized by its ardent embrace of photographic source material In 1969 he began a series of brashly beautiful motorcycle paintings that established him as one of the founders and foremost artists of the movement In his equally celebrated store window paintings Blackwell captures the counterpoint between the idealized reality within the store display and the bustling urban life reflected in the glass As author Linda Chase remarks in her essay The magic of these paintings resides in the artist's ability to transform the arbitrary photographic information into dynamic and complex artistic compositions revealing and clarifying the image while preserving its mystery The first comprehensive resource on an icon of photorealism this volume includes further essays by esteemed art writers Louis K Meisel and Carter Ratcliff *An Ontology of Multiple Artworks* David Davies, 2024 David Davies examines the ontology of multiple artworks such as books and musical performances He argues against a theory of multiple works as types that are independent of creative and appreciative acts instead defending a view on which they are performances essentially embedded in artistic practices **Painting and Presence** Anthony Rudd, 2022 This book is concerned with why or whether paintings have value why they might be worth creating and attending to The author traces an understanding of painting as ontologically revelatory from the theology of the Byzantine Icon to classical Chinese appreciations of landscape painting and Phenomenologists inspired by European Modernist art *Philosophy of Religion and Art* Gregory E.
