When ready to run the program ensure the learner is attending and provide the SD "brush your teeth" and begin prompting beginning at step 1 - 11 (steps 6-9 can be in any order and time spent brushing should be increased with toleration & independence)

Data Collection: For your data collection write the date in the top column and the prompt used for each step in the vertical column associated with the step.
