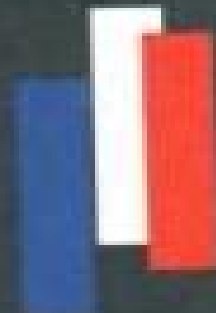

An illuminating exploration of the tensions between self and society in the age of revolutions Since the eighteenth century one of the defining concerns of modern life has been the tension between the self and society we believe in a person's autonomy but we also acknowledge that people are shaped by social and cultural forces The Revolutionary Self delves into this paradox turning to the eighteenth century as an era when new ideas about the self society and equality gained traction and new ways of living emerged Lynn Hunt the eminent historian of the French Revolution traces the rise of individualism and how it transformed attitudes In this thoughtful and surprising history she examines women's expanding societal roles such as using tea to facilitate conversation between the sexes and women pushing boundaries by becoming artists Class also comes under stress with the French lower classes laughing at printmakers' ribald portrayals of the elite to soldiers rising in the French army for skill and not pedigree The invention of financial instruments at this time like life insurance and the national debt is related to the changing idea of national identity Wide ranging and thought provoking The Revolutionary Self is a fascinating exploration of the conflict between individualism and the group ties that continues to shape our lives today

War and the World Jeremy Black,2008-10-01 In this brilliant history of warfare Jeremy Black is the first to approach the entire modern era from a comprehensive global perspective He provides a wide ranging account of the nature purpose and experience of war over the past half millennium and argues the importance of viewing the rise of European power within a wider international context Investigating both land and sea warfare Black examines weaponry tactics strategy and resources as well as the political social and cultural impact of conflict The book takes issue with established interpretations not least those that emphasize technology and challenges the view that European military and naval forces were dominant throughout the period European mastery at sea did not always translate into equivalent success on land says Black and many non

European military systems the Ottomans in their expansionist years Babur and the Mughals in sixteenth century India and the Manchu in China in the following century for example were formidable in their own right The author contends that in the nineteenth century the focal period of Europe s military revolution the international military balance shifted decisively Black shows how military developments combined with political economic and ideological shifts influenced the nature and success of European imperialism Linking debates on early modern history with those of more recent centuries he offers a fundamental reexamination of the role of war in the progress of nations War, Revolution, and the Bureaucratic State : Politics and Army Administration in France, 1791-1799 Howard G. Brown,1995-08-03 This book examines a period of particular importance in the formation of the modern French state The revolutionary strife and international war of the 1790s had important and far reaching consequences for the development of democracy and bureaucracy in France Howard G Brown s study of changes in army administration in this period sheds light on the dynamic relationship between the spread of political participation the rationalization of public power and the build up of military might Dr Brown shows how the exigencies of war and the vagaries of revolutionary politics wrought rapid and profound changes in the structures and personnel of army administration Although loath to see a massive military bureaucracy take root legislators found that their desire to combine civilian control with military effectiveness made a large central administration unavoidable
