Cross, 2012-12-06 The subject of baptism continues to be of considerable interest though it frequently appears within broader studies of sacraments liturgy worship and ecumenical studies and within confessional bounds credobaptist or paedobaptist yet it is rarely discussed by Evangelicals This book however is neither an apologetic for credobaptism nor paedobaptism rather Cross believes that as practiced today both forms are a departure from New Testament baptism which he maintains was an integral part of becoming a Christian and part of the proclaimed gospel He argues that the one baptism of Ephesians 4 5 is conversion baptism and that the baptism referred to in the various New Testament strata refers to this one baptism of Spirit and water
