Recovering the Evangelical Sacrament Anthony R. Cross, 2012-12-06 The subject of baptism continues to be of considerable interest though it frequently appears within broader studies of sacraments liturgy worship and ecumenical studies and within confessional bounds credobaptist or paedobaptist yet it is rarely discussed by Evangelicals This book however is neither an apologetic for credobaptism nor paedobaptism rather Cross believes that as practiced today both forms are a departure from New Testament baptism which he maintains was an integral part of becoming a Christian and part of the proclaimed gospel He argues that the one baptism of Ephesians 4 5 is conversion baptism and that the baptism referred to in the various New Testament strata refers to this one baptism of Spirit and water

The study sets out the case for this interpretation and contends that in key passages baptism is an example of synecdoche. The case is then made for a sacramental interpretation of baptism from a thoroughgoing Evangelical perspective. Cross concludes with reflections on the necessity of baptismal reform and the relevance of a return to conversion baptism for the contemporary church in a post Christian post Christendom mission setting.

Liturgical Music as Ritual Symbol Judith Marie Kubicki, 1999. In this book Sister Kubicki uses Jacques Berthier's Taize music to explore the nature of liturgical music as ritual symbol. She carries out a hermeneutical analysis of Berthier's chants and examines biographical and historical data related to the creators of Taize music and the founding of the Taize community. The author draws on five areas of study to interpret the Taize chants as ritual symbol: symbol theory, semiotics, theologies of symbol, ritual theory, and performative language theory. The final chapter explores potential ecclesial meanings which may be mediated in the Taize liturgy and the role of Berthier's chants in mediating that meaning. The study concludes that it is music's symbolic property that enables it to be both ministerial and integral to the liturgy. As symbolic activity, music making evokes participation, negotiates relationships, and enables the assembly to orient themselves and to find their identity and place within their world. Furthermore, music making provides the illocutionary force to do something in the act of singing. Thus it is that as part of a complexus of ritual symbols, music interacts with other symbols in mediating the liturgy's meaning.

Christian Character Formation Gifford A. Grobstein, 2019. This work argues that Christian righteousness is bestowed and becomes active primarily in worship, particularly through the congregational use of the means of grace, and that the proper appropriation of this righteousness by a Christian is ethically formative.

The Cleansing of the Heart Reginald M. Lynch, 2017. Recalling the Biblical and Patristic roots of the Church's sacramental identity, the Second Vatican Council calls the Church the visible sacrament of that unity offered through Christ. LG 9, Sacrament, in this sense, not only describes who the Church is but what she does. In this regard, the Council Fathers were careful to establish a strong connection between the symbolic nature of the Church's sacraments and their effect on those who received them. Reginald Lynch is concerned with the cleansing of the heart, a phrase borrowed from St. Augustine and employed by Aquinas, which describes the effects that natural elements such as water or bread have on the human person when taken up by the Church as sacramental signs. Aquinas' approach to sacramental efficacy is unique for its integration of diverse theological topics such as Christology, merit, grace, creation, and instrumentality. While all of these topics will be considered to some extent, the primary focus of *The Cleansing of the Heart* is the sacraments understood as instrumental causes of grace. This volume provides the historical context for understanding the development of sacramental causality as a theological topic in the scholastic period, emphasizing the unique features of Aquinas' response to this question. Following this, relevant texts from Aquinas' early and later work are examined, noting Aquinas' development and integration of the idea of sacramental causality in his later work. *The Cleansing of the Heart* concludes by contrasting alternatives to Aquinas' theory of sacramental causality that subsequently emerged. The rise of humanism introduced many changes within

Toward a Priestly Christology Adriani Milli Rodrigues,2018-11-02 Toward a Priestly Christology is a constructive theology on the person and work of Christ from the standpoint of a systematic thinking about his priesthood This priesthood is usually discussed in biblical scholarship on the Christology of Hebrews and also explored in historical or systematic theology with its connections with soteriology and ecclesiology However there is a scarcity of studies that attempt to systematize this topic in its basic components and their ontological foundations in order to provide conceptual clarity for a constructive discussion of the priestly Christology in systematic theology The book makes a contribution to this discussion by engaging firstly with the main models of Christ s priesthood in Christian theology and then with a theological reading of the letter to the Hebrews In both steps the author conceptually articulates the priesthood in terms of need agent actions and goal Then he observes the conceptual articulation from the macro hermeneutical point of view of ontology especially noticing how assumptions on time and space impact the internal logic of Christ s priesthood By using existing models of this priesthood as heuristic tools for systematic thinking the work attempts to push Christian theology toward a more dynamic understanding of Christ s priesthood especially regarding the relationship between the ascended Christ and our Christian life
