neuro imaging techniques allowing for an evaluation of developmental changes in the human brain In sum we are now starting to put together a more and more coherent picture of how numerical competencies develop and how this development is associated with neural changes as well In the end this knowledge might also lead to a better understanding of the reasons for atypical numerical development which often has grievous consequences for those who suffer from developmental dyscalculia or mathematics learning disabilities Therefore this Research Topic deals with all aspects of numerical development findings from behavioural performance to underlying neural substrates from cross sectional to longitudinal evaluations from healthy to clinical populations To this end we included empirical contributions using different experimental methodologies but also theoretical contributions review articles or opinion papers
