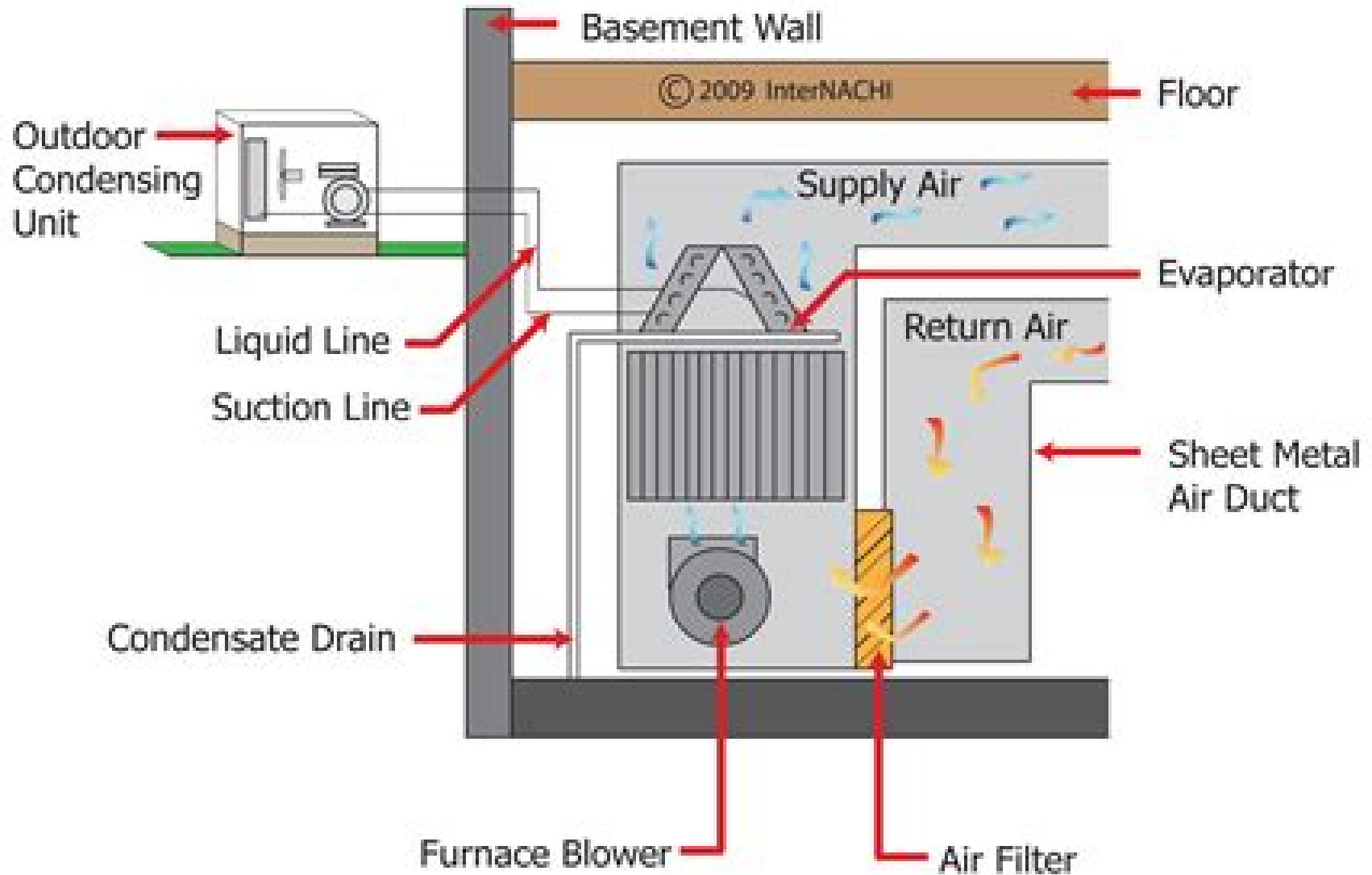


Split System Air Conditioning
