Kaplan, 2009-01-01 Baudelaire's Prose Poems is the first full length integral study of the fifty prose poems Baudelaire wrote between 1857 and his death in 1867 collected posthumously under the title *Le Spleen de Paris* Edward Kaplan resurrects this neglected masterpiece by defining the structure and meaning of the entire collection which Kaplan himself has translated as *The Parisian Prowler* Engaging in a dialogue with deconstructionists whose critical methods often obscure the meaning of the whole Kaplan rejects the view of prose poems as a random assemblage of melodic rhapsodies Instead he sees a coherent ensemble of fables of modern life that join lyricism and critical self awareness Kaplan defines three dimensions of experience that inform *The Parisian Prowler* from beginning to end the esthetic includes art ideal beauty and especially the intense immediacy of sensations fantasy and dream the ethical includes principles of right and wrong relations between intimates or between individuals and the community and the religious not to be confused with church or dogma points to the province of ultimate reality whether it be God or an absolute standard of truth justice and meaning These dimensions are explored by a narrator a complex highly self conscious writer whose passion for pure Beauty continually frustrates his yearning for affection He begins his tour through 1850s Paris alienated from reality becomes aggravated by conflicts between his ethical and esthetic drives to the point of despair and ends by expressing loyal friendship Analyzing the fables in relation to one another in pairs or groups Kaplan demonstrates how later pieces intermingle or even confuse the narrator's esthetic and ethical drives and how the most advanced

theoretical fables through ironic puns on their form further undermine this simplistic dualism Baudelaire's fables of modern life radically challenge us to examine our presuppositions Kaplan argues Though rarely didactic the narrator's Socratic irony engages readers in a volatile dialogue provoking them to form their own judgments He often betrays self destructive anger rebelling against injustice or stupidity or against women who might love him At times he insults our complacency and self deception with vicious glee at other times he recognizes his own frailty nurturing a sense of fellowship with the oppressed Seeking both to analyze experience objectively and to sympathize with isolated individuals like himself Baudelaire's narrator joins criticism and poetry in a voyage of self discovery finally accepting experience as impure and mixed Kaplan contends that the prose poems constitute a genre parallel to the poems Baudelaire added to the 1861 edition of *Les Fleurs du Mal* both of which illustrate fundamental principles of the theory of modernity he developed in his essays on art The self reflective fables in *The Parisian Prowler* depicting a way of thinking beyond ideologies clarify Baudelaire's development as poet critic and thinker

The Moment of Rupture Humberto Beck, 2019-07-26 An instant is the shortest span in which time can be divided and experienced In an instant there is no duration it is an interruption that happens in the blink of an eye For the ancient Greeks *kairos* the time in which exceptional unrepeatable events occurred was opposed to *chronos* measurable quantitative and uniform time In *The Moment of Rupture* Humberto Beck argues that during the years of the First World War the Russian Revolution and the rise of fascism in Germany the notion of the instant migrated from philosophy and aesthetics into politics and became a conceptual framework for the interpretation of collective historical experience that in turn transformed the subjective perception of time According to Beck a significant juncture occurred in Germany between 1914 and 1940 when a modern tradition of reflection on the instant spanning the poetry of Goethe the historical self understanding of the French Revolution the aesthetics of early Romanticism the philosophies of Søren Kierkegaard and Friedrich Nietzsche and the artistic and literary practices of Charles Baudelaire and the avant gardes interacted with a new experience of historical time based on rupture and abrupt discontinuity Beck locates in this juncture three German thinkers Ernst Jünger Ernst Bloch and Walter Benjamin who fused the consciousness of war crisis catastrophe and revolution with the literary and philosophical formulations of the instantaneous and the sudden in order to intellectually represent an era marked by the dissolution between the extraordinary and the everyday *The Moment of Rupture* demonstrates how Jünger Bloch and Benjamin produced a constellation of figures of sudden temporality that contributed to the formation of what Beck calls a distinct regime of historicity a mode of experiencing time based on the notion of a discontinuous present

Mallarmé and Wagner: Music and Poetic Language Heath Lees, 2017-07-05 This book challenges and replaces the existing view of Mallarmé's mission to re possess music on behalf of poetic language Traditionally this view focused on only the last fifteen years of the poet's life and sprang from a belief in Mallarmé's sudden awakening to music during an all Wagner concert in Paris in 1885 Professor Heath Lees shows that Mallarmé's early knowledge and experience of music was much greater than

commentators have realized and that the French poet actually began his writing career with the explicit aim of making music's performance language of effect the ground of his poetic expression. Integral to the argument is Mallarmé's reaction to the work and ideas of Richard Wagner whose impact on France came in two waves: the first broke during the tempestuous 1860s days of the Paris Tannhäuser while the second arrived in the mid 1880s and gave birth to the *Revue Wagnérienne*. In refuting the critical literature that focuses on only the second of these waves, Lees shows that Mallarmé exhibited a highly informed Wagnerian background during the first wave and that his grasp of the composer's gestural motives and flexible musical prose led him towards a new kind of self-expressive gestural rhythm that aimed musically to reinvent poetic language. In support of this, the book examines closely what Wagner really said in the prose works that were becoming known in Paris by the 1860s, in particular Wagner's important French text, the *Lettre sur la musique*. It also re-examines Baudelaire's classic Wagner brochure and reveals its author's surprisingly firm grasp of Wagner's musico-poetic fusion. In musically informed commentary, Professor Lees surveys the four decades of success and failure that resulted from Mallarmé's repeated attempts to draw out the musical gestures and resonances of words alone. In the process, he throws new light on many of Mallarmé's best-known texts hitherto judged difficult by those who have failed to.

Constellations of Reading Carlo Salzani, 2009. How to read Walter Benjamin today. This book argues that the proper way is through an approach which recognizes and respects his own peculiar theorization of the act of reading and the politics of interpretation that this entails. The approach must be figural, that is, focused on images and driven by the notion of actualization. Figural reading in the very *sui generis* Benjaminian way understands figures as constellations whereby an image of the past juxtaposes them with an image of the present and is thus actualized. To apply this method to Benjamin's own work means first to identify some figures. The book singles out the Flâneur, the Detective, the Prostitute, and the Ragpicker, and then sets them alongside a contemporary account of the same figure: the Flâneur in Juan Goytisolo's *Landscapes after the Battle* (1982), the Detective in Paul Auster's *New York Trilogy* (1987), the Prostitute in Dacia Maraini's *Dialogue between a Prostitute and her Client* (1973), and the Ragpicker in Mudrooroo's *The Mudrooroo Miller Project* (1993). The book thereby, on the one hand, analyses the politics of reading Benjamin today and, on the other, sets his work against a variety of contemporary aesthetics and politics of interpretation.

Poetry, Politics, and the Body in Rimbaud Robert St. Clair, 2018-08-30. Bodies abound in Rimbaud's poetry in a way that is nearly unprecedented in the nineteenth-century poetic canon: lazy, creative, rule-breaking, queer, marginalized, and impoverished bodies; revolting and revolutionary historical bodies. The question that *Poetry, Politics, and the Body* seeks to answer is: What does this corporeal density mean for reading Rimbaud? What kind of sense are we to make of this omnipresence of the body in the Rimbaudian corpus, from first to last, from the earliest poems in verse celebrating the sheer simple delight of running away from wherever one is and stretching one's legs out under a table to the ultimate flight away from poetry itself? In response, this book argues that the body appears often literally as a kind of gap, breach, or aperture through which Rimbaud's poems

enter into contact with history and a larger body of other texts Simply put the body is privileged lyrical material for Rimbaud a figure for human beings in their exposed finite creatureliness and in their unpredictable agency and interconnectedness Its presence in the early work allows us not only to contemplate what a strange sensuous thing it is to be embodied to be both singular and part of a collective it also allows the poet to diagnose and the reader to perceive a set of seemingly intractable real socio economic political and symbolic problems Rimbaud s bodies are in other words utopian bodies sites where the historical and the lyrical the ideal and the material do not so much cancel each other out as become caught up in one another

NOP HS *Atmosphere, Architecture, Cinema* Michael Tawa, 2022-12-05 Atmosphere Cinema Architecture Thematic Reflections on Ambiance and Place explores cinema and architecture as ambient and affective settings or circumstances that can enable the emergence of atmosphere This book is an interdisciplinary reading of cinematographic practice which develops useful implications for spatial composition in art and architectural design The way a film is set up directed composed framed and technically constructed can provide parallels analogies and metaphors for the spatial organisation of cities landscapes and buildings Likewise the way a built setting is conceived and devised can inform approaches to framing and spatial organisation in cinematography The book begins on a personal note with a series of recollected atmospheric experiences leading to an investigation of ambiguity and consilient discrepancy as circumstantial conditions necessary for the production of atmosphere The mood of melancholia is explored to show the pivotal role that ambiguity discrepancy and irresolution play in its distinctive ambiance Atmosphere is then defined as an emergent condition arising between an ambient affective circumstance and a mooded human being The book then moves to analyse the inherent conditions in the setup of filmic and architectural settings that render them atmospheric Reference is made to the cinema of Bresson Resnais Lynch Tarr Malik and Campion and to Romanesque tympanae the architectonic scenography of Franz Kafka s novel The Castle and the work of Spanish architects Flores Prats The concluding section Anatomy of Atmosphere is a lexicon of concepts themes

and tactics around atmosphere that might usefully inform creative practice

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unlike a normal chemical reaction that forms molecules nuclear reactions result in the transformation of one element into another this property of nuclear reactions is used in nuclear power plants to gather nuclear energy the three common types of radiations are explained below

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a nuclear reactor consists of the following a nuclear fuel a fissionable isotope must be present in large enough quantities to sustain a controlled chain reaction the radioactive isotope is contained in tubes called fuel rods a moderator

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transmutation the changing of one chemical element into another transmutation involves a change in the nucleus or core of an atom and is therefore a nuclear reaction transformations may result from nuclear decay of radioactive isotopes or they can result from neutron capture

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in all accelerators the particles move in a vacuum to avoid collisions with gas molecules when neutrons are required for transmutation reactions they are usually obtained from radioactive decay reactions or from various nuclear reactions occurring in nuclear reactors

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nuclear reaction a nuclear reaction is a process in which two nuclei or a nucleus and an external subatomic particle collide to produce one or more new nuclides the nuclear reaction is a reaction that involves nucleoids the reactant nucleoid called the parent nucleoid usually transforms into a different nucleoid called the daughter

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transmutation can be achieved either by nuclear reactions in which an outside particle reacts with a nucleus

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beryllium 8 and a positron are produced by the decay of an unstable nucleus neptunium 239 forms from the reaction of
uranium 238 with a neutron and then spontaneously converts into plutonium 239
